3. Using the method described above, I have reviewed the professionals' fee applications which are the subject of this hearing. I prepared the Report of Professional Fees and Expenses for Current Period (8/01/03 - 11/30/03) and Cumulative Case to Date (4/06/01 - 11/30/03) which is attached hereto as Exhibit 1. It is the intent of the report to give the court, the debtor, the creditors' committee, and interested parties (a) a broad overview of the cost of the bankruptcy case; (b) an approximation of the cost of specific matters so the court and knowledgeable parties can assess the reasonableness of fees; and (c) sufficient detail with respect to attorneys, accountants, billing rates, billing trends to isolate areas in which better billing discretion might be utilized.
