OPINION BY ADMINISTRATIVE JUDGE EDWARD HOURY

This appeal arose under Contract No. 054881, between the Forest Service, U. S. Department of Agriculture, and Hi-Ridge Lumber Company of Yreka, California (Appellant). The contract was known as the Mud Thinning Timber Sale, on the Shasta-Trinity National Forest in California.

The Forest Service represented that Payment Unit Number 2 of the sale included 592 acres. Appellant contended that this area included only 394 acres and that there was a comparable reduction in the timber volume available. The Contracting Officer had the area remeasured, concluding in a September 28, 1998 decision that the area included 429 acres. Appellant filed a timely appeal of this decision.

On October 14, 1998, the Board docketed Appellant's appeal and requested the filing of a Complaint

within 30 days from the receipt of the Board's letter. By facsimile letter dated November 17, 1998, Appellant advised the Board as follows:

After meeting with the Forest Service to discuss our concerns and evaluate the calculation of the payment unit area and additional field work, Hi-Ridge Lumber Company is withdrawing its appeal.

DECISION

The appeal is dismissed.
