## The CEFPI/Healthy Schools Network's Action List:

Repair roof leaks; remove water-damaged or moldy carpets

Get fresh air: restore high ceilings and windows that open

Ban mercury and other toxic products; use safer alternatives

Prevent pests; use only least-toxic pest control products

Stop lead: abate, repair walls with flaking paint; test tap water

Use only durable, easy to clean flooring

Protect students from construction fumes, dust, and debris

Set up a system to address occupant health & safety issues

Ban junk food: have a kitchen that makes wholesome meals and snacks

<u>Remember</u>: a healthy school supports health, education, and the environment. Nothing is more 'back to basics' than a little fresh air and sunshine indoors.
