# These risk behaviors 1...

# **Unintentional Injuries and Violence**

16% Rarely or never wore safety belts

28% Rode with a drinking driver during the past month

14% Carried a weapon during the past month

31% Were in a physical fight during the past year

8% Attempted suicide during the past year

### Alcohol and Other Drug Use

46% Drank alcohol during the past month

27% Reported episodic heavy drinking during the past month

28% Used marijuana during the past month

8% Ever used cocaine

NA<sup>2</sup> Ever used inhalants

### Sexual Behaviors

41% Ever had sexual intercourse

10% Ever had four or more sex partners

30% Had sexual intercourse during the past three months

43% Did not use a condom during last sexual intercourse<sup>3</sup>

77% Did not use birth control pills during last sexual intercourse<sup>3</sup>

### **Tobacco Use**

53% Ever tried cigarette smoking

21% Smoked cigarettes during the past month

10% Smoked cigarettes on ≥ 20 days during the past month

4% Used smokeless tobacco during the past month

12% Smoked cigars during the past month

### **Dietary Behaviors**

**NA** Ate < 5 servings of fruits and vegetables per day during the past 7 days

82% Drank < 3 glasses of milk per day during the past 7 days

### **Physical Activity**

39% Participated in insufficient vigorous physical activity 4

76% Participated in insufficient moderate physical activity 5

42% Were not enrolled in physical education class

86% Did not attend physical education class daily

11% Did not participate in any vigorous or moderate physical activity


