# **Unintentional Injuries and Violence**

7% Rarely or never wore safety belts

22% Rode with a drinking driver during the past month

NA2 Carried a weapon during the past month

27% Were in a physical fight during the past year

7% Attempted suicide during the past year

### Alcohol and Other Drug Use

44% Drank alcohol during the past month

26% Reported episodic heavy drinking during the past month

28% Used marijuana during the past month

NA Ever used cocaine

NA Ever used inhalants

### **Sexual Behaviors**

NA Ever had sexual intercourse

11% Ever had four or more sex partners

31% Had sexual intercourse during the past three months

40% Did not use a condom during last sexual intercourse 3

69% Did not use birth control pills during last sexual intercourse<sup>3</sup>

### **Tobacco Use**

NA Ever tried cigarette smoking

22% Smoked cigarettes during the past month

11% Smoked cigarettes on ≥ 20 days during the past month

**74%** Ate < 5 servings of fruits and vegetables per day during the past 7 days

52% Were not enrolled in physical education class


