

- Customizable





Features


- Create unlimited calendars
- Remote event submission
- Calendar merge
- Security
 - "Private" events
 - Password protected
- Customizable template
- Template generator





Remote Event Submission

- Password protected
- Direct submission- event is automatically added to calendar (manual or automated)
- Moderated submission- the WebCalendar creator administrator reviews all events (whether public or private) and then posts on the calendar (manual only)
- Unlimited number of login/password accounts can be created with the professional version



From Many→One

- Multiple calendars can be created from a single licensed copy of the Professional version
 - LHD would use Remote Event Submission to populate their own individual calendar
 - Calendars can then be merged into master calendars

Calendar Merge

- Master Calendars created by merging selected calendars
 - Merge locals → regions → state
- There is no limit to the number of calendars that can be merged
- Autonomy AND coordination!

MI Implementation

- Installation on a single server (single license)
 - Create unlimited number of web calendars
 - Automated publishing (3AM) or manual (on demand)
- Requirements:
 - 1 email address per calendar (for remote submission)
 - Local, regional, and state buy-in
