Parentage Testing in Tokyo, Japan

Parentage testing may be necessary for a U.S. citizen parent to transmit U.S. citizenship when primary evidence of a parent-child relationship is insufficient. If you wish to proceed with parentage testing please review the steps below, the attachments and websites of the U.S. Department of State <http://travel.state.gov and American Association of Blood Banks (AABB)

- 1. Choose and contact one of the U.S. Embassy approved medical examiners. Inform the examiner that you are seeking DNA parentage testing for U.S. citizenship purposes. It is up to examiner to agree take your case or not.
- 2. Choose and contact one of the AABB accredited parentage testing laboratories in the U.S. Inform the laboratory that the specimens will be drawn in Japan and give them the name and address of the examiner.
- 3. Inform the examiner of the laboratory's name and address and ask the examiner to request from the laboratory the test kit and detailed instructions.
- 4. Make an appointment with the examiner to have your specimens drawn.
- 5. Notify us in writing of your arrangements. The laboratory $\underline{\text{must}}$ send the original results directly to us. You may request the laboratory to send a copy of the results to you. We can only take further action after receiving the original results directly from the laboratory and considering them in light of citizenship law.
- 6. You are responsible for paying all necessary costs to both the examiner and laboratory. Please discuss all logistical, procedural and cost questions directly with the examiner and laboratory since we cannot act as your advocate in this process.
