SUBJECT: Expand Standard Date Format and Remove CWF (Common Working File) Y2K

Wrapper Logic for Fiscal Intermediary Claims/Trailers and Carrier/DMERC

Trailers – Incoming and Response Transactions

Background

Windowing (wrapper) logic surrounds dates processed in the CWF system. It determines the century for internal processing, but does not add or save the century on the date year fields. All external dates used as input to CWF include the century. Bridge programs at CWF's front-end strip the century FROM dates before going into CWF, and a bridge program on the back end adds the century to dates before being returned to the sender. The wrapper logic allowed CWF to be Y2K-compatible, but not Y2K-compliant.

This change modifies the CWF system by including the century on all process dates, dates in working storage, and dates used in CICS inquiries. These dates will all have the common signed packed Julian format of "CCYYDDD" (PIC S9(7) COMP-3). Multiple one-time utilities will be created to convert internal system dates to the common date format and the CWF system will be modified to process all dates in this format.

A phased implementation approach is being used with portions of the system being upgraded in a series of quarterly releases. This change will modify CWF to accept the Inpatient (HUIP), Outpatient (HUOP), Home Health (HUHH), and Hospice (HUHC) claim records in the new, standardized date format (CCYYDDD). CWF will modify the incoming bridge program to not strip the century from dates for these transactions, to remove the wrapper logic, and to modify the outgoing bridge programs to prevent the response files from being reformatted incorrectly.

In addition to the claim transactions listed above, certain trailers will be modified to use the "CCYYDDD" standard date format throughout. Fiscal Intermediaries, Carriers and DMERCs will be impacted by this change regarding the trailers listed below respectively. Also impacted, are the response records, the unformatted provider inquiry (HUQA), and the claim overflow area.
