Between April 1, 1998 and June 30, 1998, the Division of Inspections and Surveillance received 1,457 error and accident reports from the American Red Cross (ARC), 1,494 error and accident reports from non-ARC licensed blood establishments, 81 error and accident reports from unlicensed registered blood establishments, 271 error and accident reports from plasma centers, 2 reports from transfusion services, 7 reports from blood derivative manufacturers, 6 reports from in-vitro diagnostic manufacturers, 1 report from a vaccine manufacturer, 2 reports from allergenic manufacturers, and 1 report from a therapeutic manufacturer. A total of 3,322 error and accident reports were received. There were 445 (13.4%) reports forwarded to the District Offices for follow-up and evaluation as potential recall situations. Based on the information submitted in the error and accident reports, 214 (6.4%) reports did not appear to meet the threshold for reporting, i.e., products were not made available for distribution or the safety, purity, or potency of a product was not affected.

Between October 1, 1997 and June 30, 1998, the Division of Inspections and Surveillance received a total of 9,682 error and accident reports. There were 1233 (12.7%) reports forwarded to the District Offices for follow-up and evaluation as potential recall situations. Based on the information submitted in the error and accident reports, 666 (6.9%) reports did not appear to meet the threshold for reporting, i.e., products were not made available for distribution or the safety, purity, or potency of a product was not affected.

Attached are tables and charts that identify the types of reportable and non-reportable errors and accidents submitted. Examples of errors and accidents in the top three categories are provided. A table and graphs representing reportable errors and accidents are also provided that illustrate the distribution of the reporting time, i.e., time from the date the error or accident was discovered to the date CBER received the report.





# ALL BLOOD AND PLASMA ESTABLISHMENTS POTENTIAL RECALLS



# AMERICAN RED CROSS FY98



# ERROR AND ACCIDENT REPORTS NON-ARC LICENSED BLOOD BANKS FY98






# PLASMA CENTERS FY98


# BLOOD BANKS VERSUS PLASMA CENTERS



#### Top Three Categories of Errors/Accidents:

Post Donation Information - 5801 (64.5% of reportables)

\*Examples:

Information provided post donation:

- Donor traveled to a malarial endemic area
- Donor received tattoo, earpiercing, needlestick, or transfusion
- Donor became ill after donation,

#### not related to hepatitis, HIV, HTLV-I, sexually transmitted diseases or cold/flu symptoms

- Donor had a history of cancer

Storage/Distribution - 957 (10.6% of reportables)

- \*Examples:
  - Release of product that contained clots or would not flow through a filter
  - Product was shipped or stored at incorrect temperature
  - Failure to quarantine a unit that was designated to be quarantined due to unsuitable medical history
  - Failure to quarantine a unit that was designated to be quarantined due to incorrect, incomplete, or positive testing


Labeling - 820 (9.1% of reportables)

- \*Examples:
  - Additional information on autologous unit incorrect or missing, e.g., name, social security number, or date of birth
  - Product labeled with extended expiration date
  - Incorrect product label

#### NON-REPORTABLE ERRORS/ACCIDENTS - 664 (6.9% of total reports)

#### Top Three Categories of Errors/Accidents:

Miscellaneous 269 (40.5% of non-reportables)

#### \*Examples:

- No products made available for distribution
- Destruction records incomplete, final disposition of product unknown (documentation indicates unit was suitable at time of distribution)
- Recall procedures not followed (e.g., recall not performed within appropriate time)
- Recordkeeping error/accident record is incorrect or not reviewed, testing and labeling acceptable

Labeling - 144 (21.7% of non-reportables)

#### \*Examples:

- Unit labeled with incorrect weight, volume, collection date, or facility identifiers; unit acceptable
- Unit missing label for ABO/Rh, product, or expiration date
- Unit labeled with a shortened expiration date

Donor Suitability - 87 (13.1% of non-reportables)

#### \*Example:

- Donor did not meet acceptance criteria for time interval between donations
- Donor did not meet acceptance criteria for age
- Donor did not meet acceptance criteria for total protein or SPE

<sup>\*</sup>Examples of errors and accidents represent at least 50% of reports in each category.
