
Years Necessary to Complete All Existing, Recorded, Priority 1 and 2 Health and Safety Coal Problems Under Current Allocation Formula



* The number of years are determined by dividing a state or tribes' recorded inventory by the amount of its annual AML grant spent on high priority reclamation. Thus, while other states' inventories are larger, as a minimum program state receiving an AML grant of only \$1.5 M per year, Kansas and Oklahoma will require in excess of 100 years to complete its high priority problems.
