The Office of Surface Mining Reclamation and Enforcement Directive AML-4, dated July 30, 1992, is changed to reflect that National Historic Preservation Act (NHPA) guidance for Federal High Priority Reclamation Projects is contained in the referenced guidelines below, not Appendix 10. Changes are as follows:

Paragraph 4.b.(2)(d) is changed to read as follows: "The ESC and WSC shall assure compliance with NHPA. Guidance is contained in the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation's regulations at 36 CFR Part 800."

Paragraph 7. References. Revised to include: 36 CFR Part 800, Advisory Council Regulations.

Paragraph 11, <u>List of Appendices</u>. Changed to read as follows: "10 - Abandoned Mine Land Emergencies - Compliance with National Historic Preservation Act."
