## NOAA Fisheries Establishes Effective Dates For Vessel Monitoring Systems (VMS) On Directed Shark Vessels

The National Marine Fisheries Service (NOAA Fisheries) published a final rule in the Federal Register on August 17, 2004 (69 FR 51010), that lifts the stay on the requirement to have a NOAA-approved, VMS unit installed and operating on vessels with a directed shark limited access permit. The VMS requirement provides that:

- As of **November 15, 2004,** directed shark vessels with gillnet gear onboard, regardless of location, will be required to have VMS installed and operating during Right Whale Calving Season (November 15 March 31); and,
- As of **January 1, 2005**, directed shark vessels with bottom longline fishing gear onboard that are located between 33° and 36° 30' N latitude will be required to have VMS installed and operating during the mid-Atlantic shark closure (January 1 July 31).

The VMS requirement was finalized on December 24, 2003 (68 FR 74746), and was delayed pending a type-approval notice that was published on April 15, 2004 (69 FR 19979). The final rule will make the requirement effective but not modify the substantive requirements.

NOAA Fisheries has a limited number of VMS units available to lend to fishermen who currently have a directed shark permit.
