SUBJECT: Corrections to: Changes to the Hospital Inpatient Prospective Payment Systems and Rates and Costs of Graduate Medical Education, etc.; as Published in the Federal Register, FY 2003 (67 FR 49982, August 1, 2002)

This Program Memorandum (PM) corrects certain wage index values and hospital geographical classifications that were published incorrectly in the Federal fiscal year (FY) 2003 Federal Register.

Changes to PRICER will be made to incorporate these new wage entities. Inform the affected hospitals of these changes.

FY 2003 Revisions to the Wage Index and Capital Geographic Adjustment Factors (GAF)

The following chart reflects corrections to the wage indexes published in Table 4A, in the August 1, 2002, **Federal Register** (67 FR 50214 – 50221). These changes are effective for discharges occurring on or after April 28, 2003.

The April PRICER release incorrectly implements these corrected wage indexes effective for discharges on or after April 1, 2003. The wage indexes published in the August 1, 2002 Federal **Register** will remain in effect for discharges occurring through April 28, 2003. A new PRICER, to be released on or about June 2, 2003, will make this correction. In addition, the April PRICER release did not incorporate the changes above to the Huntsville, AL wage indexes. The June PRICER release will also correct this oversight. Do not reprocess claims unless requested to do so by the hospital.

The following charts reflect corrections to the hospital reclassifications published in Table 9, in the August 1, 2002, **Federal Register** (67 FR 50264 - 50273). Hospitals should be paid in accordance with these designations effective for discharges occurring on or after October 1, 2002. Where this correction affects the hospital's wage index, the relevant wage indexes published in the August 1, 2002, **Federal Register** are applicable for discharges occurring on or after October 1, 2002 and before April 1, 2003. For discharges occurring on or after April 28, 2003, the wage indexes published in the tables above are effective.
