#### SUBJECT: Durable Medical Equipment Regional Carriers (DMERCs -- Additional Instructions for Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA) Implementation of National Drug Codes (NDCs) and the NCPDP Format

#### I. GENERAL INFORMATION

**A. Background**: This Program Memorandum (PM) supplies further instructions for implementation of the electronic requirements of HIPAA as well as other claim types.

DMERCs are required to be HIPAA compliant. Currently the DMERCs only accept NDC codes for oral anti-cancer drugs. For HIPAA, any drug billed in the NCPDP format will require NDC codes.

B. Policy: This PM instructs the VMS Standard System and the DMERCs to:

DMERCs must accept NDC codes for all drugs billed in the NCPDP format;

- DMERCs must accept NDC codes for oral anti-cancer drugs billed in ANSI X12N 837, NCPDP and paper;
- DMERCs must accept HCPCS for all other drugs billed in ANSI X12N 837 and paper; and
- DMERCs must return as unprocessable claims submitted with an invalid NDC using Remittance Advice Remark Code N60 and Adjustments Reason Code 16.

Remittance Advice Remark Code N60 - "A valid NDC is required for this claim/service." (Suggested language/not final)
