In addition to obtaining the documents indicated on the attached Form *DS-2000*, *Evidence Which May Be Presented to Meet the Public Charge*, you must also obtain from your employer in the United States a written statement confirming that the employment offered you is still available to you. The statement should be on the stationery of the employer's business organization and must be notarized. You should send this Notice to your employer.

DO NOT RETURN SIGNED FORM *DS-2000* UNTIL YOU HAVE RECEIVED THE EMPLOYER'S STATEMENT. IF THE EMPLOYER NO LONGER INTENDS TO EMPLOY YOU, YOU SHOULD CONSULT THIS OFFICE IMMEDIATELY FOR INSTRUCTIONS AS TO HOW TO PROCEED WITH YOUR APPLICATION.

On the date of your appointment for issuance of an immigrant visa you will be required to sign a statement confirming that you still intend to accept the employment which has been offered to you.
