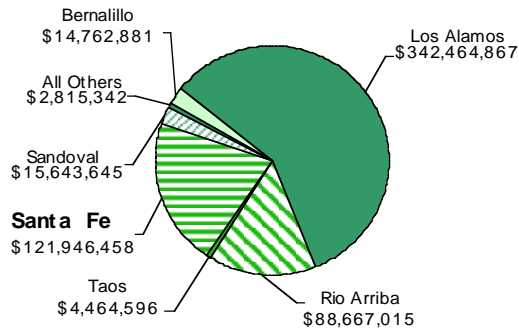


## Santa Fe Data Profile '99
