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Historical Films and Videos Duplication User Agreement

In order to safeguard archival footage from the National Library of Medicine from misuse, damage, loss, or misappropriation when it is loaned out for processing, we require all users to agree to the following procedures:

The film must be processed at a reputable film laboratory, approved by the National Library of Medicine, with experience in handling vintage footage.

- The film may not leave the National Library of Medicine for more than one month.
- All financial transactions must be conducted between the user and the laboratory.
- The film must be hand carried to and from the laboratory by a special messenger service.
- The user must take sole responsibility for meeting the copyright requirements.
- The film must be copied in its entirety; portions may not be copied.
