The Commission is in the process of a comprehensive reexamination of its rules (*see* MB Docket No. 02-277) to ensure that they reflect the current media marketplace, are based on empirical evidence, and are analytically consistent.

The hearing discussion will focus on the goals of diversity, competition and localism. Details regarding the participants and specific issues to be discussed will be provided in a subsequent public notice.

Attendance at this field hearing is open to the public. Seating will be available on a first come, first-served basis.
