NHANES 1999-2000 Public Data Release File (June 2002) Pregnancy Testing Using Urine and Blood Specimens

Description

The dual energy x-ray absorptiometry (DXA) scan is performed on survey participants 8+ years of age. The scan involves radiation exposure to the whole body. Pregnant women are excluded from the DXA procedure. Initially, a urine pregnancy test is performed. If the urine test results were positive, for pregnancy, a serum pregnancy test was also performed.

Eligible Sample

A pregnancy test is completed on female participants aged 12-59 years and menstruating females aged 8-11 years.
