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FCC ISSUES CONSUMER ADVISORY ON FCC DO-NOT-CALL RULES

The Consumer and Governmental Affairs Bureau of the Federal Communications Commission today issued an "FCC Consumer Advisory – Do-Not-Call Rules – What Consumers Can Do."

The Consumer Advisory outlines specific steps consumers can take if they have put their names on the National Do-Not-Call Registry and are called by telemarketers on or after October 1, 2003. It provides information about when there is a violation of the FCC do-not-call rules, and specifics about how to file a complaint.
