Accepted abstracts will be presented as posters and meritorious work will be presented in an oral panel session. Abstracts will be published in a proceeding of the meeting. Abstracts of papers that have been published or will be published prior to February, 2005 should not be submitted.

Requirements for Submission of Abstracts:

- Provide each author's name (first initial, second initial, last name). The presenter's name should be noted with an asterisk.
- After the name, provide one affiliation only, preferably of the presenter, in parentheses.
- Prepare abstract in a word processor.
- Do not use tabs at the beginning of a paragraph.
- Do not include figures in the abstract.
- The abstract (including title, authors, and affiliation) must not exceed 2,100 characters with spaces and hard returns (character count can be checked in Word).
- Use Times New Roman font face 12 point.
- Use single line spacing.
- Separate paragraphs with 2 hard returns.
- Do not use full or right justification.
- Abstract should include objectives, methods, results, and conclusion sections.

Notification of acceptance or rejection will be made by December 15, 2004.
