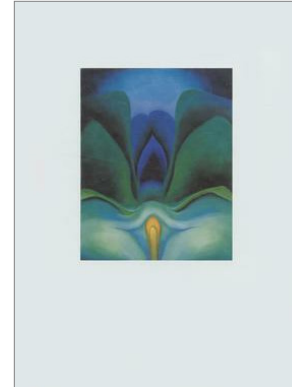


Alfred Stieglitz: The Key Set

Numbering 1,642 photographs, the collection represents the full range of the master photographer's work—from early studies made in Europe, to views of the majestic New York skyline, to incomparable intimate portraits of O'Keeffe.

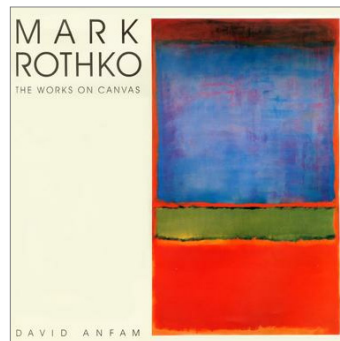


Georgia O'Keeffe: Catalogue Raisonné
