SUBJECTS: Optional Use of Form FSA-1007 in Lieu of Peanut Weight Certificates

and

Revised Instructions for Preparing 2003-Crop Peanut Warehouse Receipts

Background:

The 2002 Farm Security and Rural Investment Act converted the Peanut Program from a quota price support system into a marketing assistance loan program. For the 2002 peanut crop year, United States Warehouse Act (USWA) warehouse operators were required to maintain peanut weight certificates in addition to the form FSA-1007. For the 2003 crop year, form FSA-1007, with alterations, may be used as a peanut weight certificate. For the 2003 crop year, there are changes to the warehouse receipt information. The warehouse receipt form has not changed so that existing supplies may be used.

Purpose:

This notice provides instructions for altering form FSA-1007 to make it acceptable as a peanut weight certificate for each assigned receiving or shipping location and warehouse. This notice also revises the instructions for properly preparing a warehouse receipt for peanuts.

Action:

ALTERATION OF FORM FSA-1007

USWA Warehouses (See Exhibit 1)

The USWA Peanut Warehouse Licensee may make the following alterations in order to use form FSA-1007 as an acceptable Nut Weight Certificate: (These alterations may be made by computer, typewriter, or rubber stamp.) [Note the location on the attached sample.] The fourth copy of this document, when used as a weight certificate, is the basic source document for movement of peanuts into and out of the warehouse for any purpose.

Notes: (1) Each location referred to in instruction No. 6 has at least one warehouse operator approved weigher. For scales to be usable, (i) warehouse operators must have control of the scales used to weigh peanuts, (ii) the scales must be inspected and certified as accurate by a State agency or a qualified scale company, (iii) a copy of the inspection report must be maintained at the warehouse office for the warehouse examiner's review, and (iv) the scale must be checked by the warehouse operator for accuracy on a routine basis.

(2) The fourth copy of FSA-1007 is the DACO copy and must be maintained in a numerical file for both inbound and outbound shipments. The examiner will be verifying inbound and outbound peanut movement by this document.

(3) The warehouse operator must contact KCCO – Tim Mehl, Chief, Warehouse License and Examination Division at (816) 926-6417 to submit their series of numbers to be used as weight certificate numbers (DACO Control Numbers). A separate series must be approved and used for each receiving and shipping location and warehouse.

WAREHOUSE RECEIPT PREPARATION

Attached are the instructions for preparing a Peanut Warehouse Receipt. Exhibit 3 contains instructions for USWA warehouse receipts with a sample shown in Exhibit 4. Exhibit 5 contains instructions for other warehouse receipts with a sample shown in Exhibit 6.

Note: Changes for crop year 2003 are italicized.

Notes:

- (1) Warehouse receipts may be used for a number of purposes including a Marketing Assistance Loan and proof of production for Loan Deficiency Payments.
- (2) Warehouse operators wishing to participate in FSA Price Support Division's electronic warehouse receipt (EWR) Pilot Project for the 2003 crop year must contact the Kansas City Commodity Office (KCCO) to get number series for their warehouse receipts. KCCO will work with individuals, warehouse operators with approved EWR providers, and county offices to convert receipts to EWRs if paper warehouse receipts are issued prior to the EWR project being operational. Once the EWR pilot project is operational and the warehouse operator has signed on with an approved Provider, all warehouse receipts from that warehouse operator are issued as EWRs. If a producer/depositor requests a paper warehouse receipt in lieu of an EWR, the warehouse receipt is first issued as an EWR, then placed in suspension before issuing a paper warehouse receipt. The paper warehouse receipt must be surrendered to and cancelled by the warehouse operator before removing the EWR from suspension for final cancellation.

Used by USWA warehouse operators to warehouse receipt stored peanuts.

This form is completed by the warehouse operator and the original given to the depositor or holder.

Items A1 through A5 are generally preprinted on the form but may be entered by warehouse operators.

A3 License No.	Enter the United States Warehouse Act license number of the warehouse where the peanuts are stored. This number may be preprinted on the receipt. If not preprinted, the caption "License No." should be preprinted and the number entered by the warehouse operator.
A4 Name of Warehouse	Enter the name of the warehouse where the peanuts are stored. This name may be preprinted on the form. If not preprinted, it should be entered by the warehouse operator.
A5 Location City and State	Enter the location city and state of the warehouse where the peanuts are stored. This location may be preprinted on the form. If not preprinted, it should be entered by the warehouse operator.
