Report Highlights:

Under the EU wine regime, member states can obtain annual subsidies to restructure and convert a set number of hectares to improve quality production. The European Commission recently published two decisions adopting the definitive allocation for 2002/03 and the indicative allocation for 2003/04.

EU Subsidies for the Restructuring and Conversion of Vineyards

Under the EU wine regime, member states can obtain annual subsidies to restructure and convert a set number of hectares to improve quality production.

The European Commission recently published two decisions adopting the definitive allocations for marketing year 2002/03 (Commission Decision 2003/638/EC) and an indicative allocation for marketing year 2003/04 (Commission Decision 2003/628/EC). In marketing year 2002/03, the EU paid 443.20 million Euros to restructure and convert an area of 67,971 hectares of vineyards. The available budget for marketing year 2003/04 is also 443.20 million Euros and covers 58,651 hectares. Each member state's indicative subsidy can be adjusted, within the limit of the available budget, depending on its priorities.
