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#### **Report Highlights:**

A wet spring and the early onset of warm weather reduced output and quality of Spain's 2003 strawberry crop. Despite this setback, poor crops elsewhere in Europe encouraged strong exports to Spain's traditional markets.

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#### **Executive Summary**

Spain's 2003 strawberry output reached only 300,000 tons, a 10 percent drop from the previous year. An unusually wet spring and warmer-than-normal temperatures in the primary production area created ideal conditions for molds. As a result, the quality of the crop suffered, forcing April 2003 prices down by a third from last year's levels. For the season, the wholesale price was 0.820 Euros/Kg, compared to 0.937 Euros/Kg in 2002. Total area planted to strawberries in 2003 was 8,000 hectares.

Strawberry production continues to be heavily concentrated, with nearly 95 percent coming from the province of Huelva, in the southern region of Andalucia. Much of the rest of the crop comes from the area around the city of Cadiz.

While the fresh market -- domestic and export -- continues to be the focus of the industry, about 10-to-15 percent of the fruit is diverted to industrial use for frozen strawberries, jams and flavorings.

The strawberry industry is continuing its efforts to develop varieties especially adapted to the soil and weather conditions of Huelva. Resistance to molds and fungus is a major goal of this research, since soil treatments with methyl bromide and chloropicrin are becoming problematic.

#### **Production**

Spanish strawberry production for marketing year 2003 (Jan-Dec) was 300,000 tons, a ten percent decrease from MY 2002. According to industry sources, 16 percent of the total crop came from strawberries planted under an "integrated production" system. This type of production is designed to obtain a better quality product using the different elements from the "agro system" (water, plant, soil and weather) more effectively with the goal of reducing environmental impact and keeping the production profitable. This process carefully regulates the use of pesticides.

#### Consumption

Domestic fresh strawberry consumption in MY 2003 totaled 58,000 tons, around a third lower than MY 2002. The high incidence of mold in production areas reduced both the amount of marketable fruit and its shelf life. Fresh strawberries are a popular spring fruit; they are usually served with cream or used to decorate cakes and tarts.

#### Trade

Despite the problems with the 2003 crop, strawberry exports reached an estimated 211,000 tons, or 14 percent above the previous season. The ready market for this lower quality crop reflects the problems of other early season producers in Europe. The main markets were Germany, France, United Kingdom, Italy and Belgium. Industry sources say that a significant quantity of fruit was spoiled on arrival in these markets and was returned to shippers

As Spain is a major producer and exporter of fresh strawberries, imports are generally small. For MY 2003, imports are estimated at around 8,000 tons. Most were later season fruit from France.

Frozen strawberry production for MY 2003 totaled around 25,000 tons, off a third from MY 2002. Lower deliveries to processors reflect the reduction in marketable fruit available on the market.

#### Consumption

Most frozen berries are processed into jams, yogurt and flavorings. Domestic consumption will fall only slightly in MY 2003, as most of the production shortfall will be made up with imports and carryover stocks.

#### Trade

MY 2003 exports should continue at nearly the same level as MY 2002, as processors give priority to their traditional customers in Western Europe. MY 2003 imports will rise to help fill the production shortfall. Morocco continues to be the major supplier of frozen strawberries to Spain.
