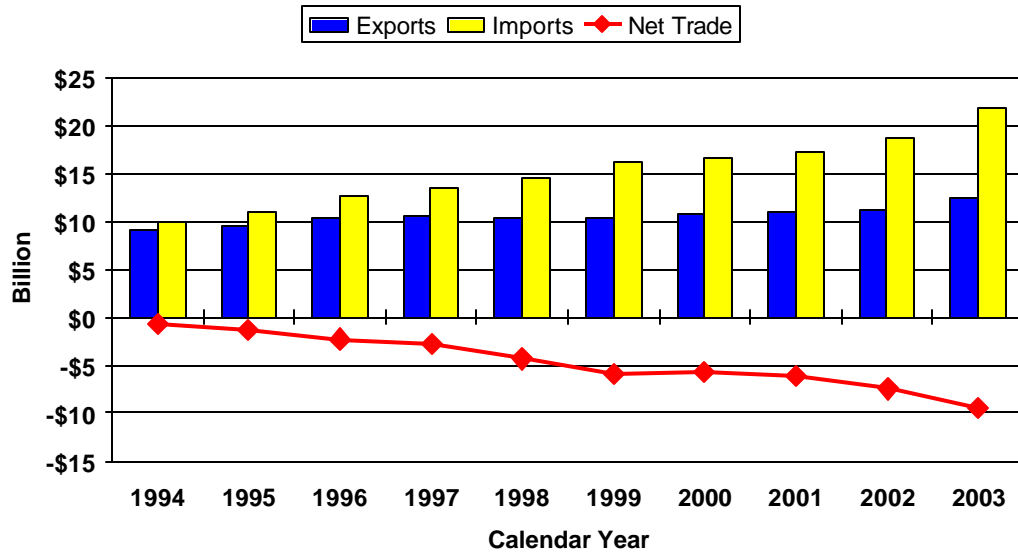
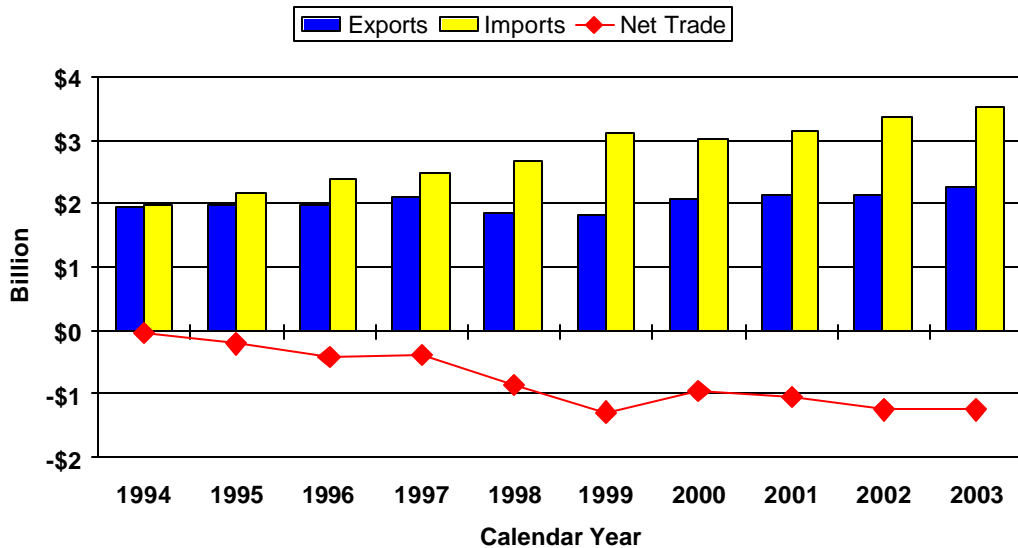


U.S. Horticultural Net Trade



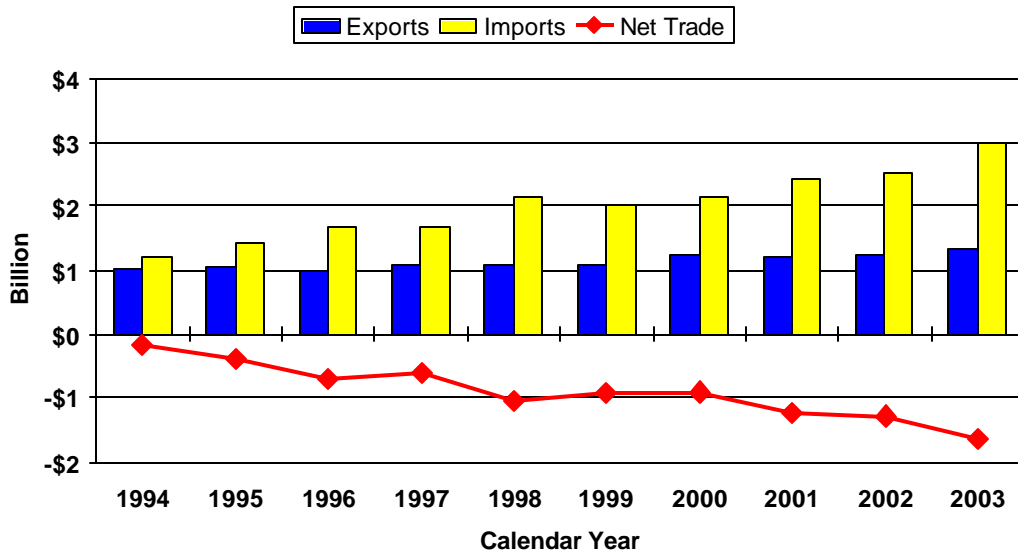

U.S. Net Trade in Fresh Fruit*



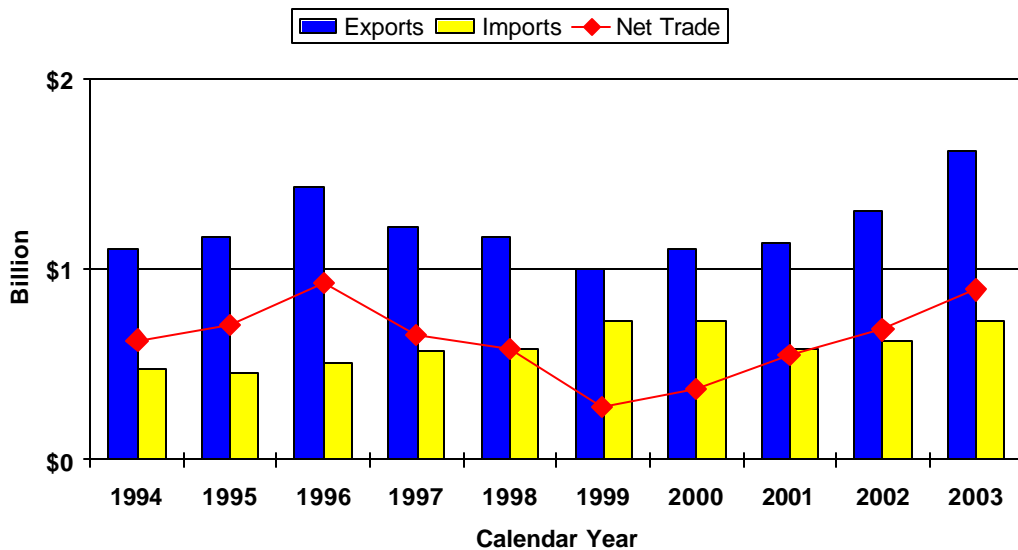

U.S. Net Trade in Fresh Vegetables



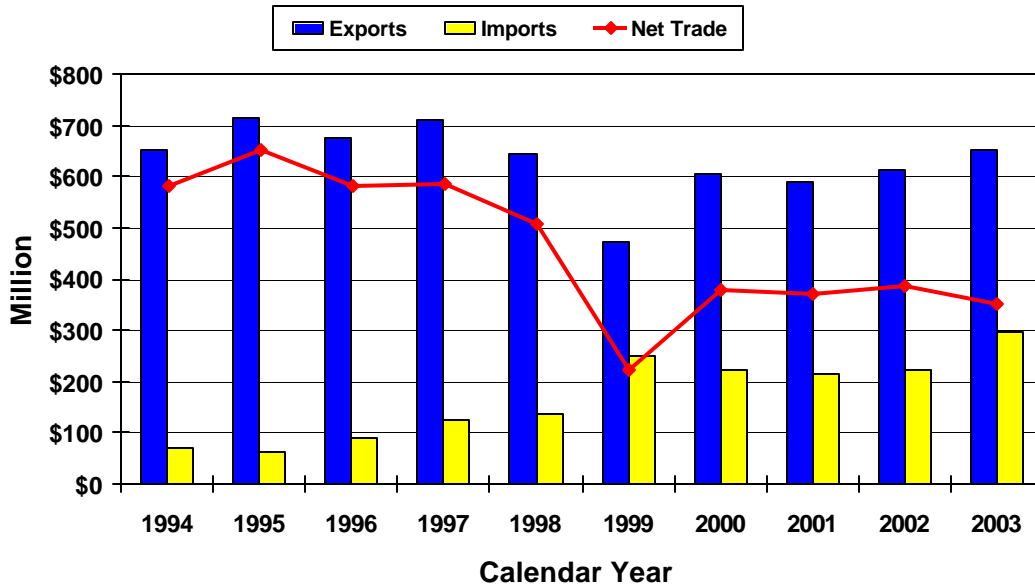

U.S. Net Trade in Edible Tree Nuts



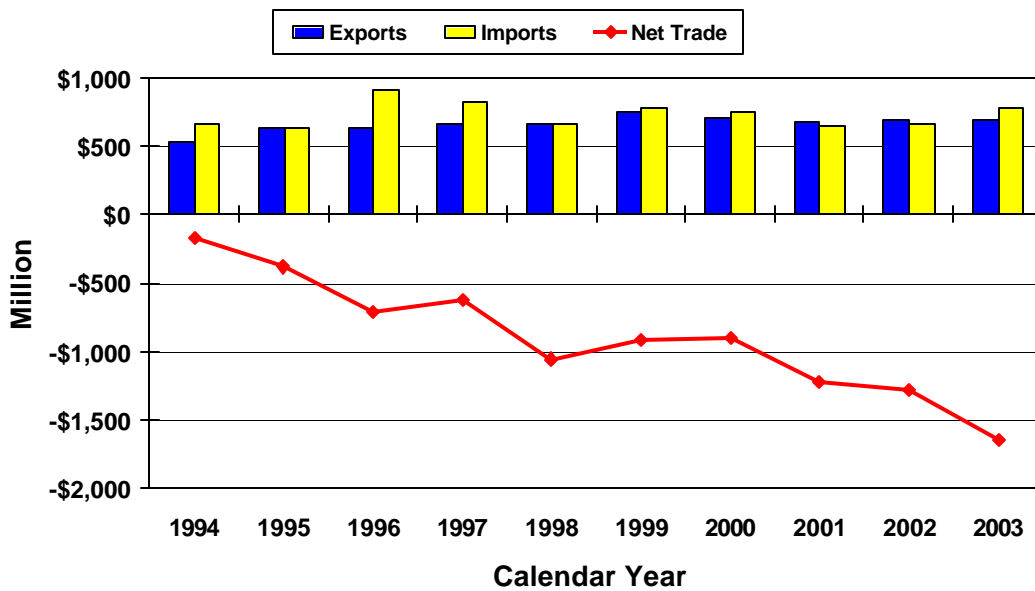

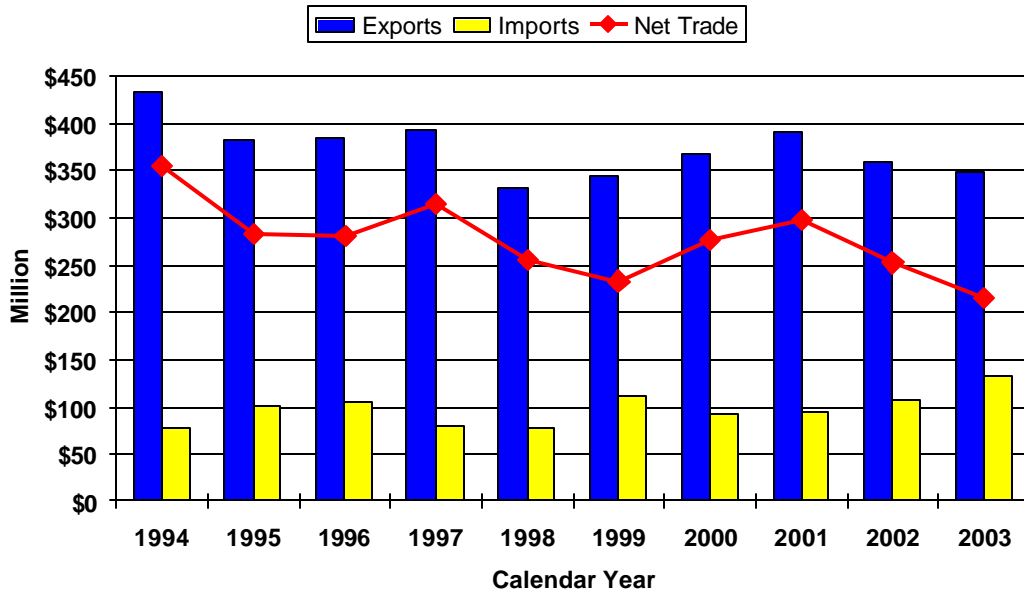

U.S. Net Trade in Fruit Juices*



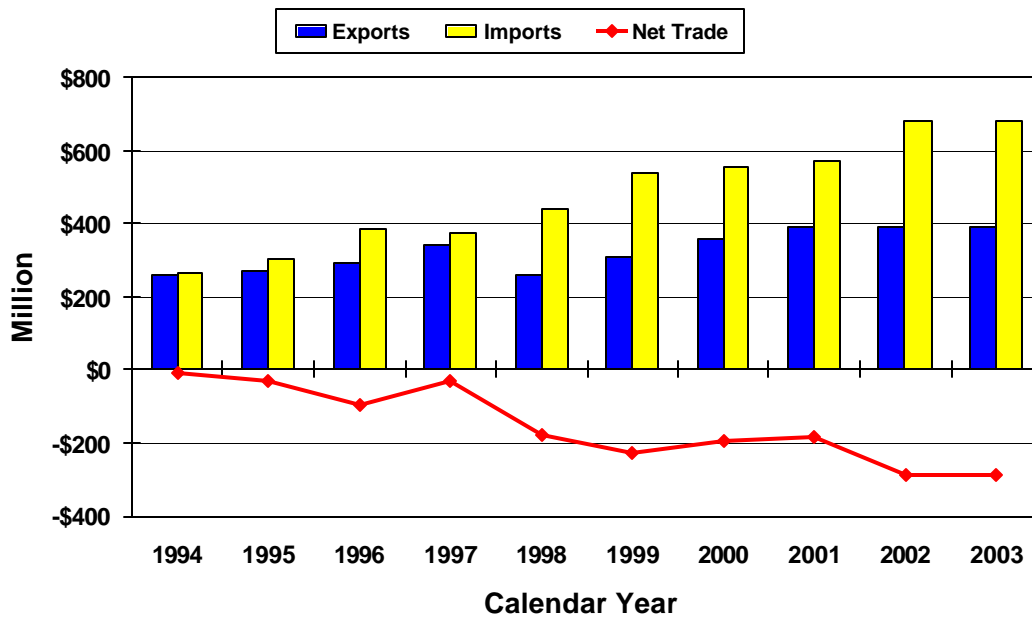

U.S. Net Trade in Fresh Apples



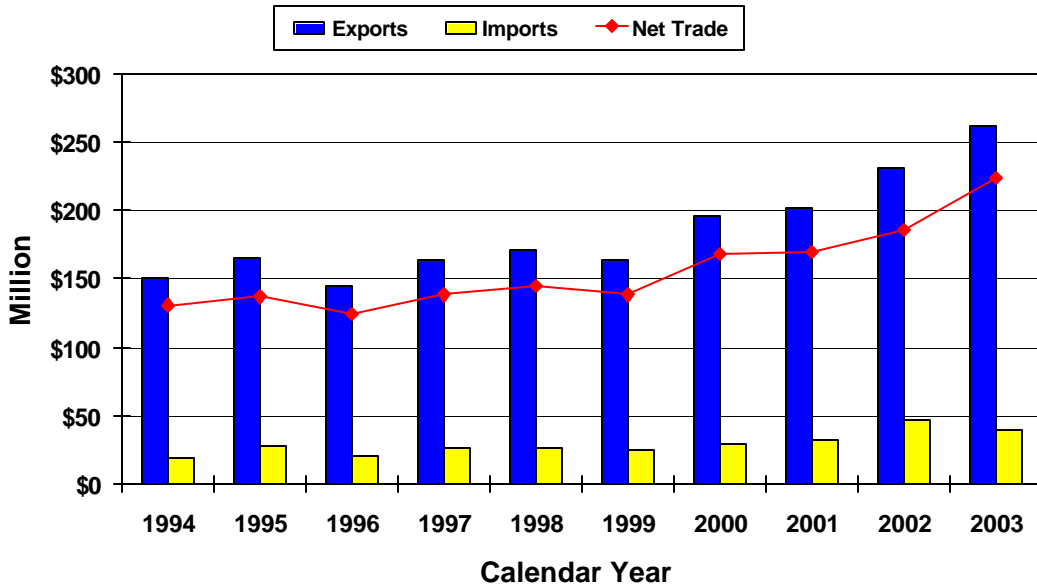

U.S. Net Trade in Fresh Table Grapes



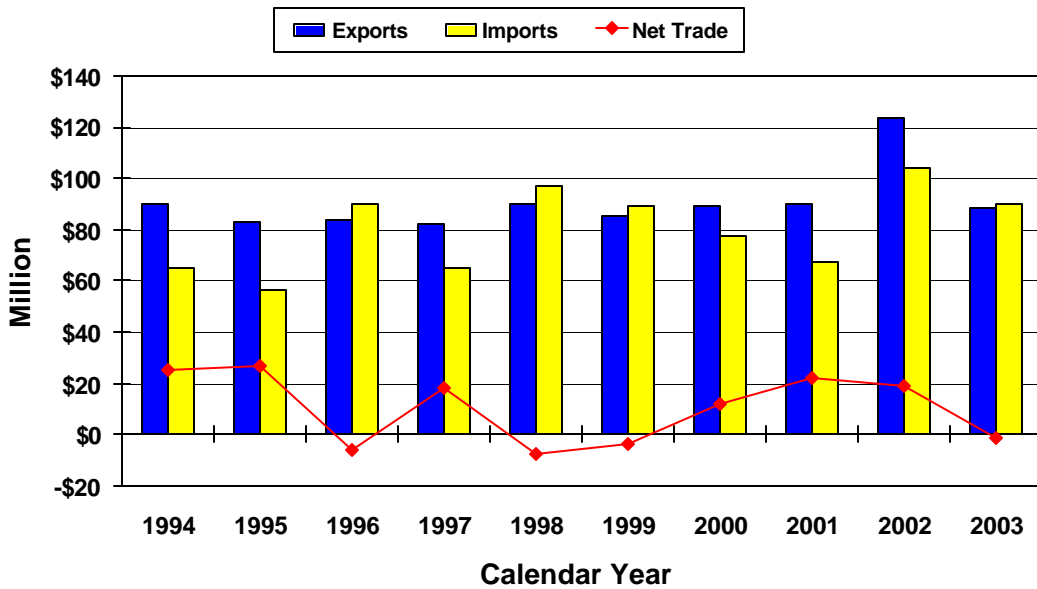

U.S. Net Trade in Fresh Lettuce*



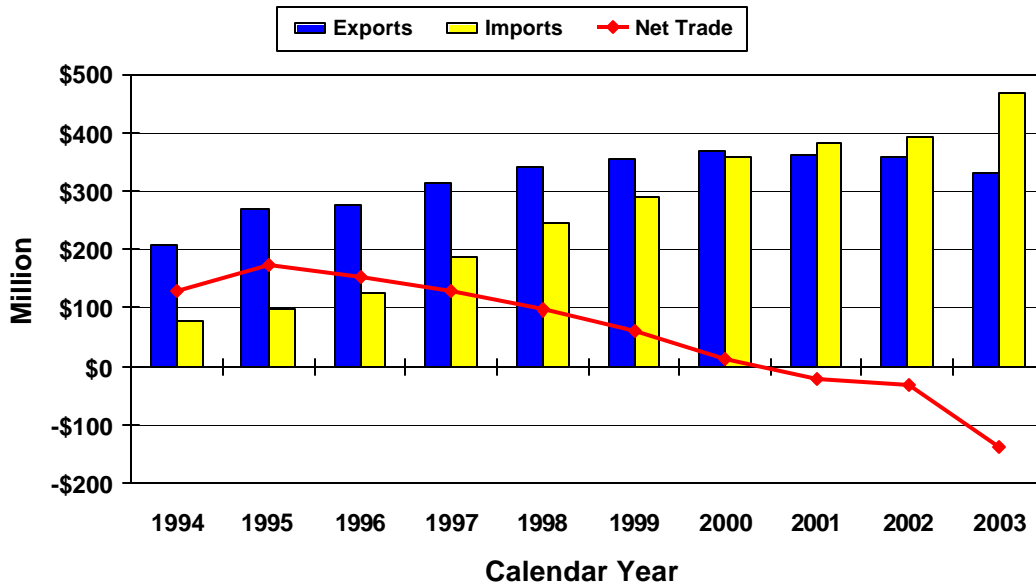

U.S. Net Trade in Fresh Potatoes*



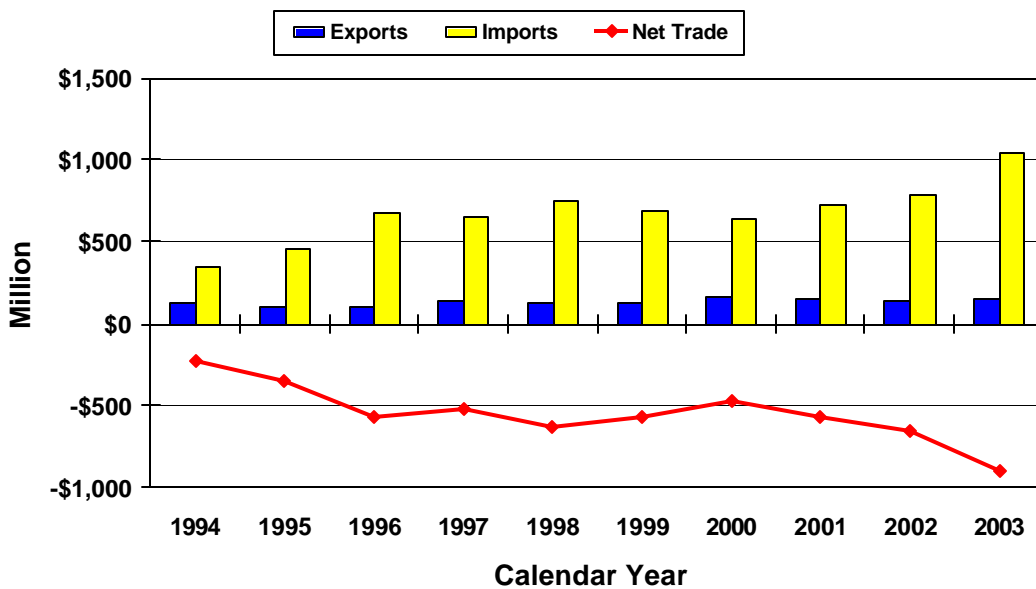

U.S. Net Trade in Frozen Potato Products



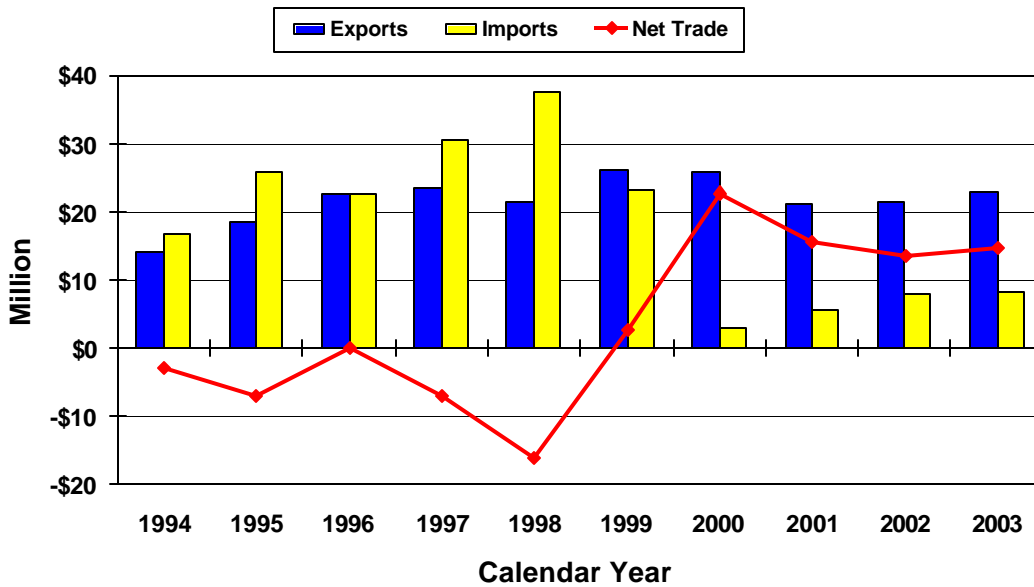

U.S. Net Trade in Fresh Tomatoes



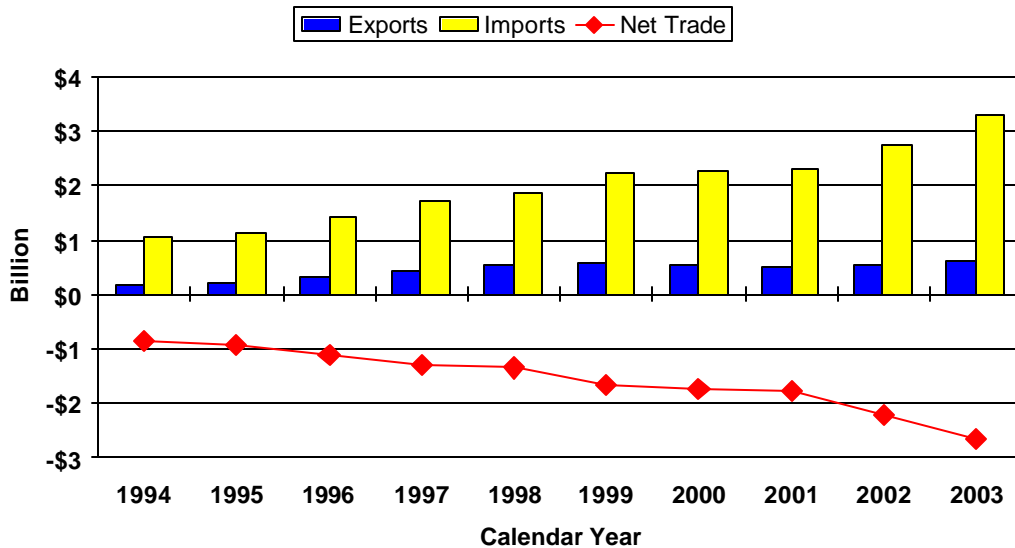
