In support of this Request for Leave to Participate, the Programs state that they have an interest in the subject of this action as specifically set forth herein and in the attached Declaration of Sherry Yarbrough.

Associated Builders and Contractors ("ABC") is a national trade association representing about 23,000 contractors, subcontractors, material suppliers and related firms from across the country and from all specialties in the construction industry. ABC represents the interests of open shop contractors. Approximately 80 percent of all construction workers are employed by merit shop companies.

Within California, ABC is represented by four separate chapters who sponsor registered apprenticeship programs. These chapters are the San Diego Associated Builders and Contractors, Golden Gate Associated Builders and Contractors, Southern California Associated Builders and Contractors, and Los Angeles - Ventura Associated Builders and Contractors (the "California ABC Chapters").

5	discriminatory statutes and regulations recently enacted by California and the California			
6	Apprenticeship Council. It is for this reason that the Programs filed complaints with the			
7	Department of Labor. As a result, in part, of these complaints, the Department of Labor			
8	ultimately initiated the derecognition proceedings now pending against the California			
9	Department of Industrial Relations and in which the Programs now request to participate			
10	as amicus curiae.

12	Given the fact that the outcome of these proceedings will determine the fate			
13	of the Programs, the Programs respectfully submit that they ought to be permitted to			
14	participate as amicus curiae.

These programs are: (1) San Diego Associated Builders and Contractors; (2) Golden Gate Associated Builders and Contractors; (3) Southern California Associated Builders and Contractors; and (4) Los Angeles - Ventura Associated Builders and Contractors.
- In total, the California ABC Chapters and their Apprenticeship Programs represent hundreds of contractors and over a thousand apprentices. One of ABC's primary functions is to implement and oversee nonunion apprenticeship training programs. Each of these California ABC Chapters sponsors a nonunion apprenticeship training program (the "Programs"). The Programs are each registered and approved by the State of California.
- 5. Under the recently enacted statutes and regulations by California and the California Apprenticeship Council which are at the center of these proceedings, the Programs have been negatively impacted and may likely be forced to cease operations. It is for this reason that the Programs filed complaints with the Department of Labor.
