

## **National Service Partners Launch New Resources**



<u>Ten Years Serving America Toolkit</u> To commerate its ten year anniversary, the <u>Corporation for National and Community Service</u> has launched its <u>10 Years Serving America</u> toolkit. The toolkit is

designed for grantees and other organizations and agencies that champion the value of national and community service. The toolkit offers resources to help organizations leverage the anniversary to engage new partners, recruit more volunteers, promote their programs, and enhance their resources.



**Emergency Financial First Aid Kit** In September, as part of National Preparedness Month, the U.S. Department of Homeland

Security, <u>Citizen Corps</u>, Federal Emergency Management Agency, <u>USA Freedom Corps</u>, and <u>Operation HOPE</u>, <u>Inc.</u> unveiled the Emergency Financial First Aid Kit at an event at the U.S. Department of the Treasury. The <u>Emergency Financial First Aid Kit</u> helps Americans minimize the financial impact of a natural disaster or national emergency. <u>Citizen Corps and Operation HOPE</u>, <u>Inc. also announced a key partnership</u> to promote financial and economic education for disaster planning and recovery.



**Building Bridges Classroom Guide** In October, Broward County Public Schools in Florida, the Nation's sixth largest school district, became the first school district to adopt the Peace Corps' Building Bridges Classroom Guide. The educational materials are designed to

assist teachers of grades six through 12 in building cross-cultural awareness, respect, and communication in their classrooms. The Broward County school district is one of the country's most diverse student bodies with students from approximately 160 countries.
