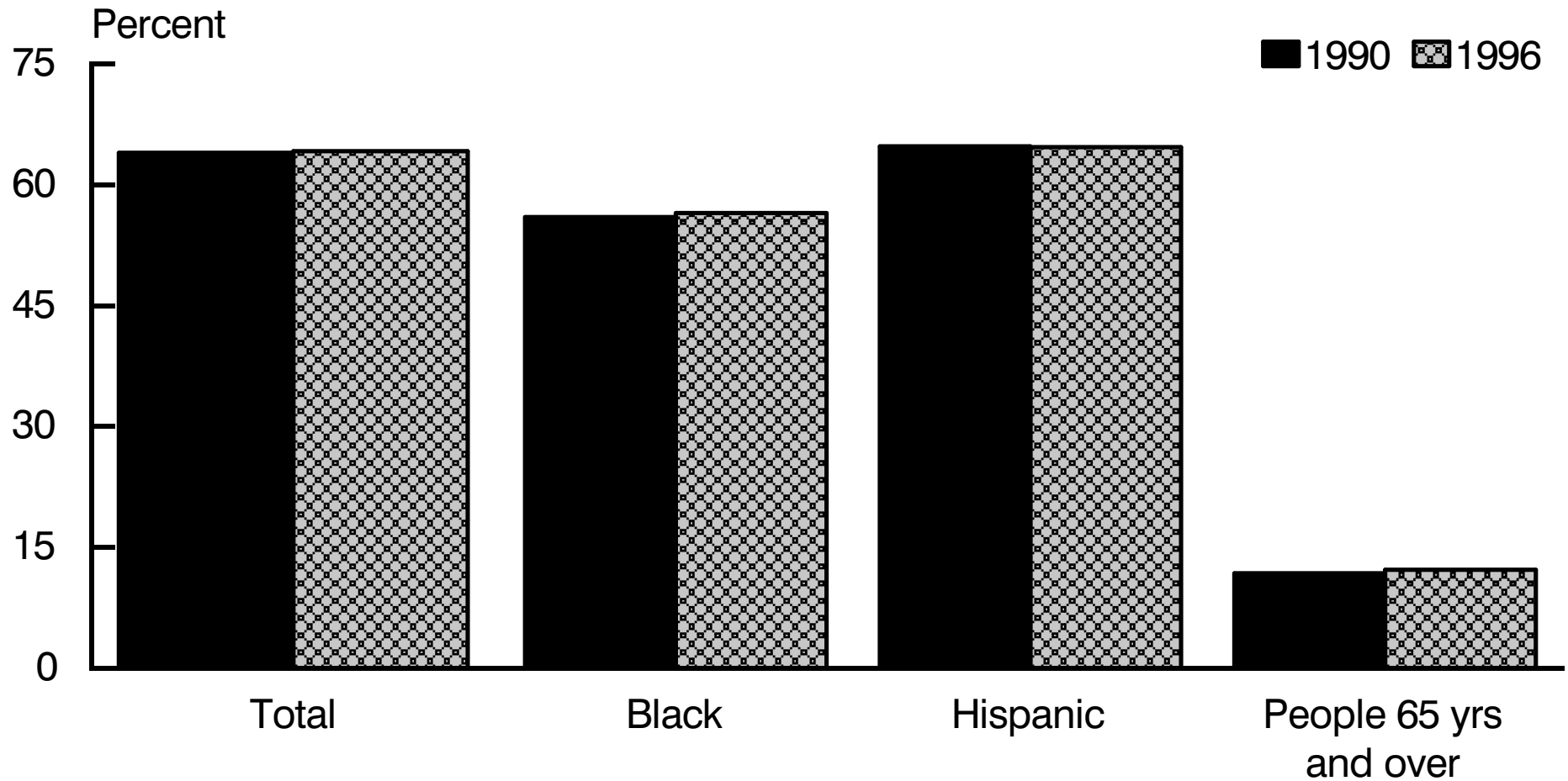


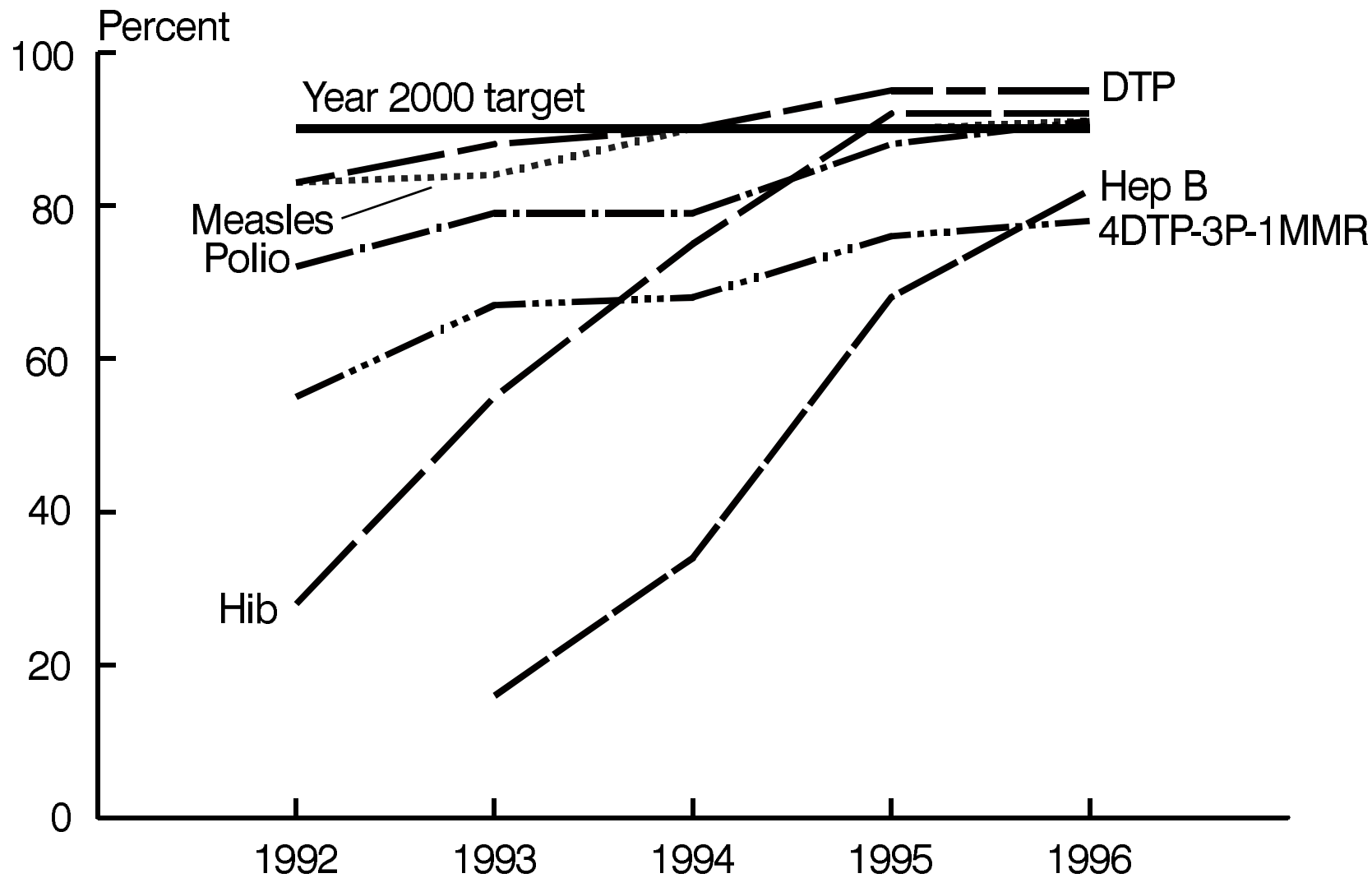

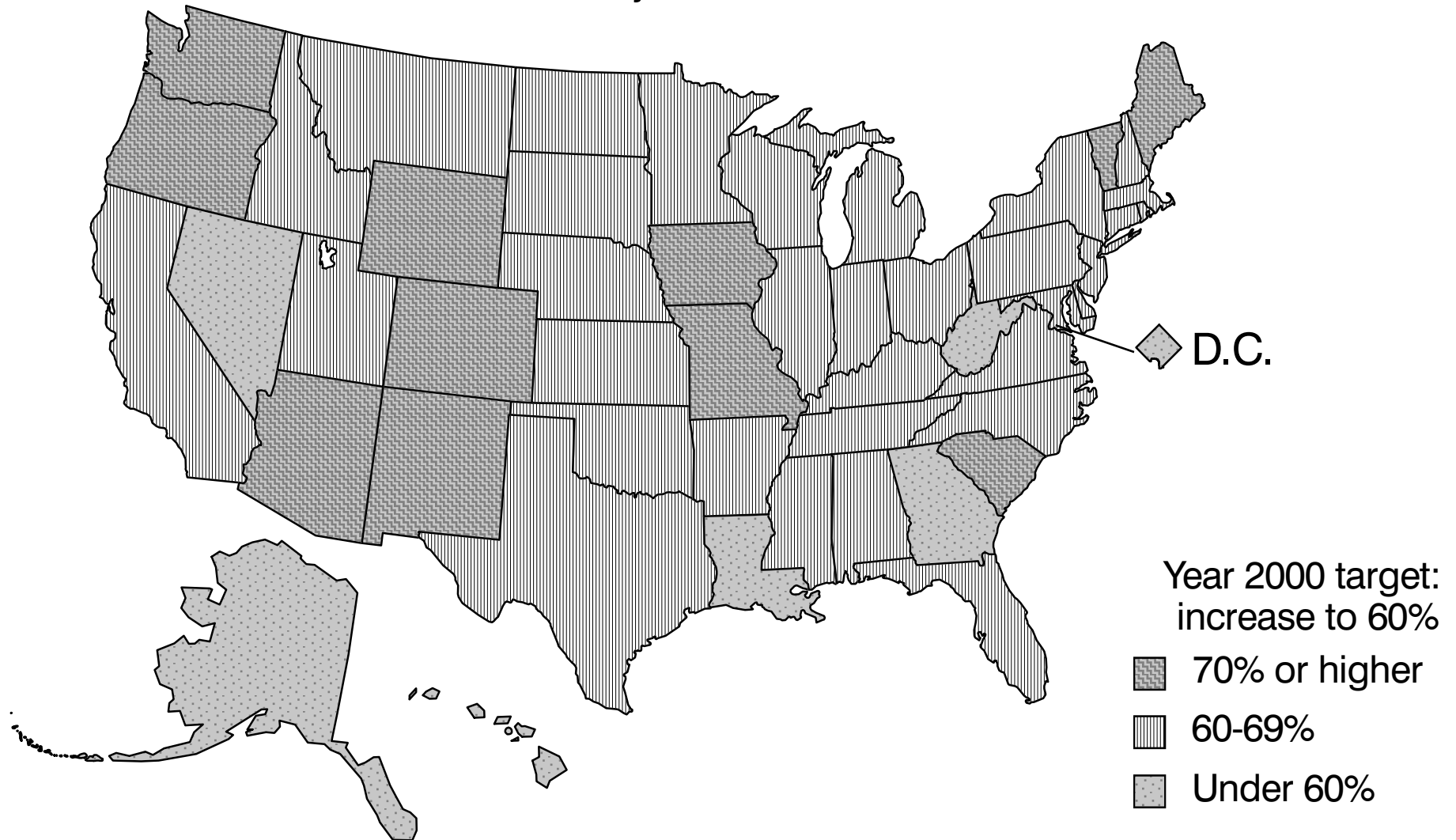
# Childhood Immunization

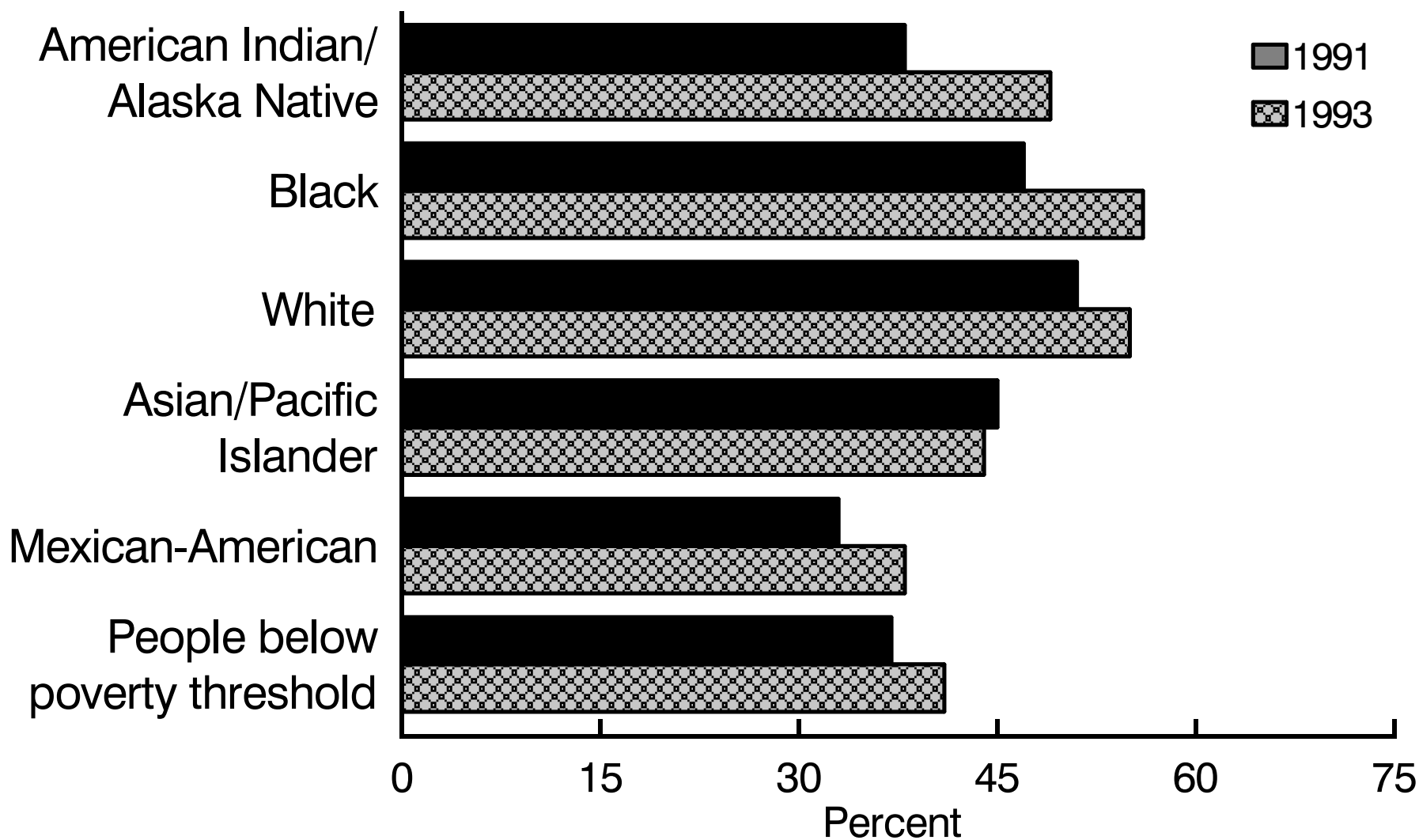
# Persons 65 years and over who had an influenza vaccination in the past 12 months

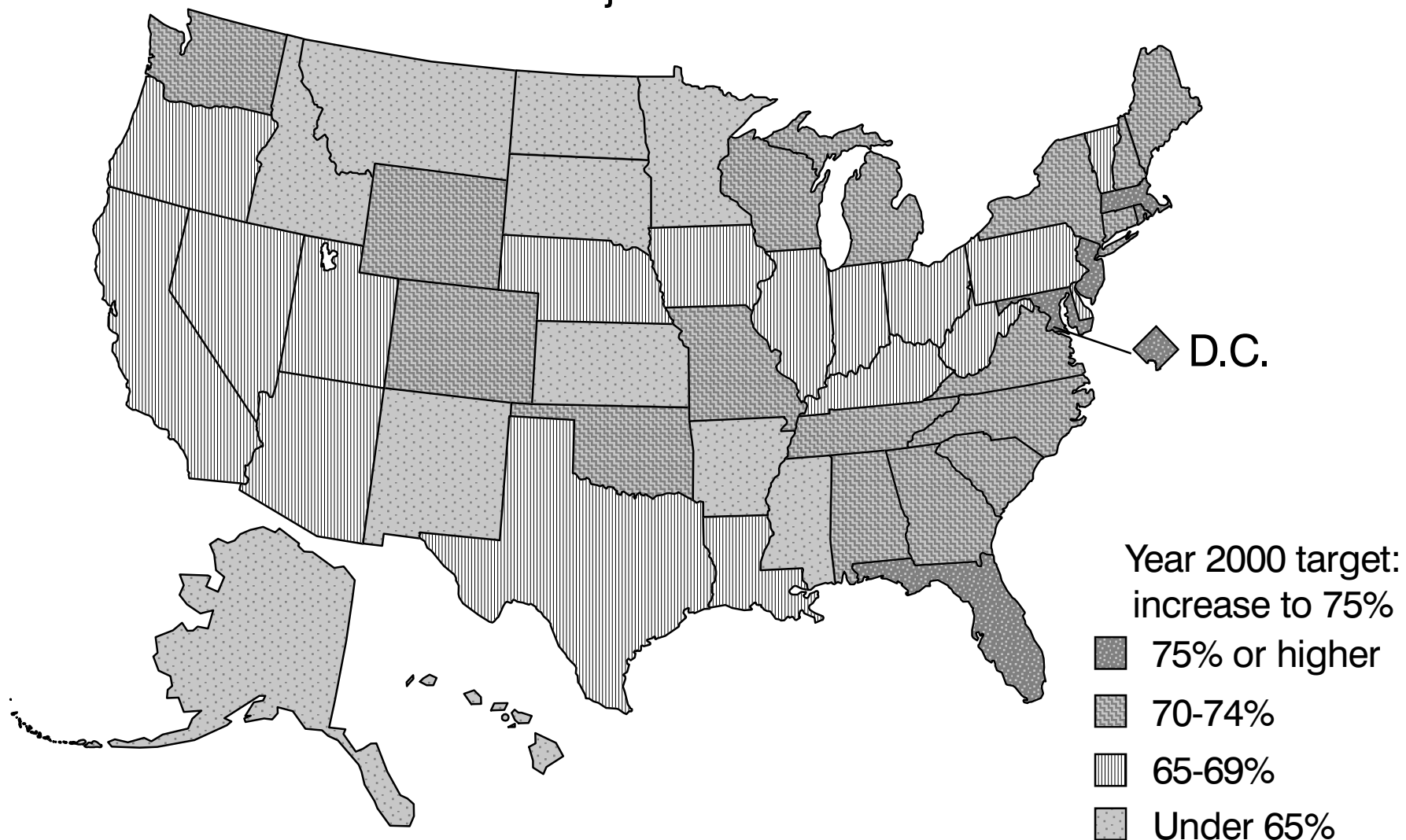
Persons 18 years and over who had cholesterol

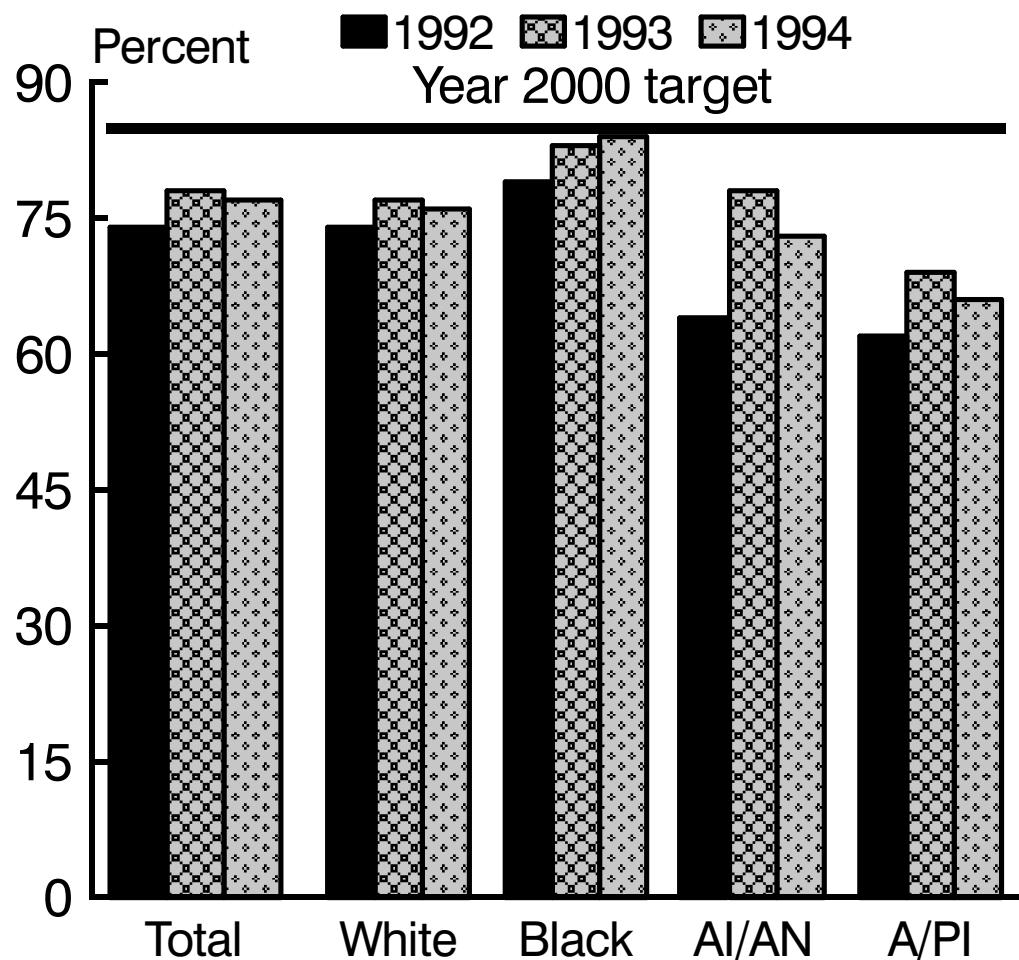

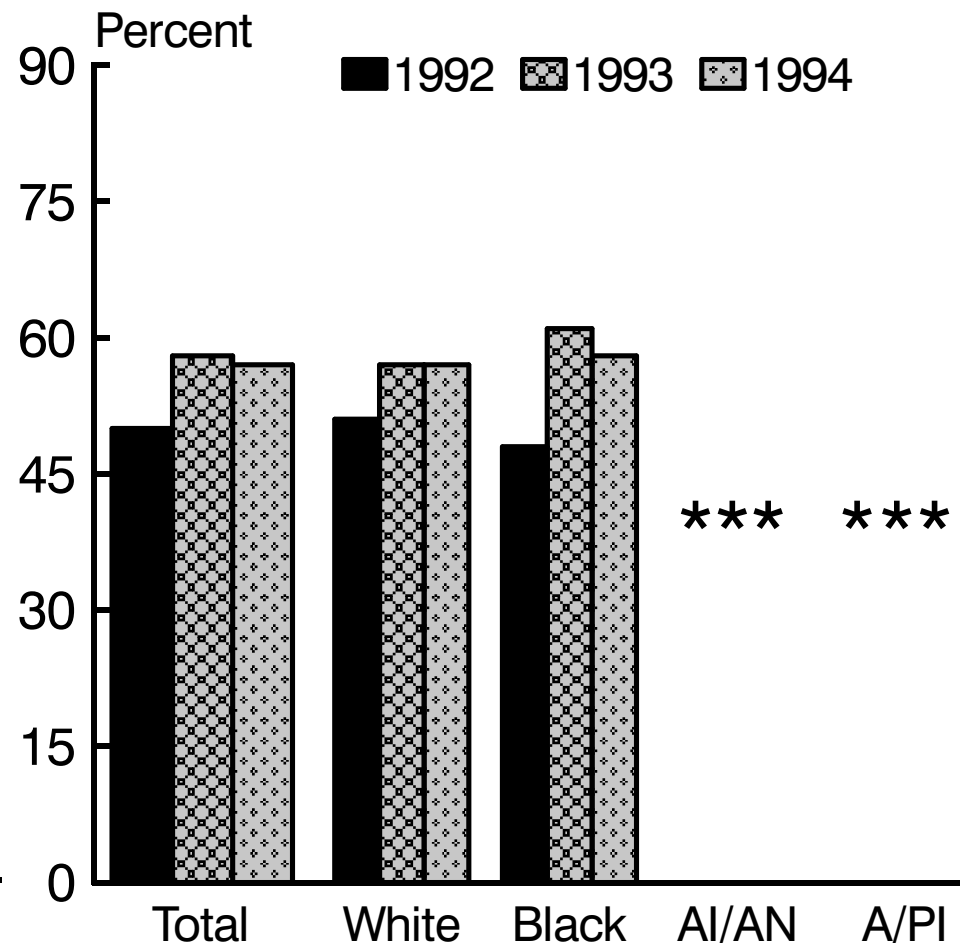
# Pap test in past 3 years

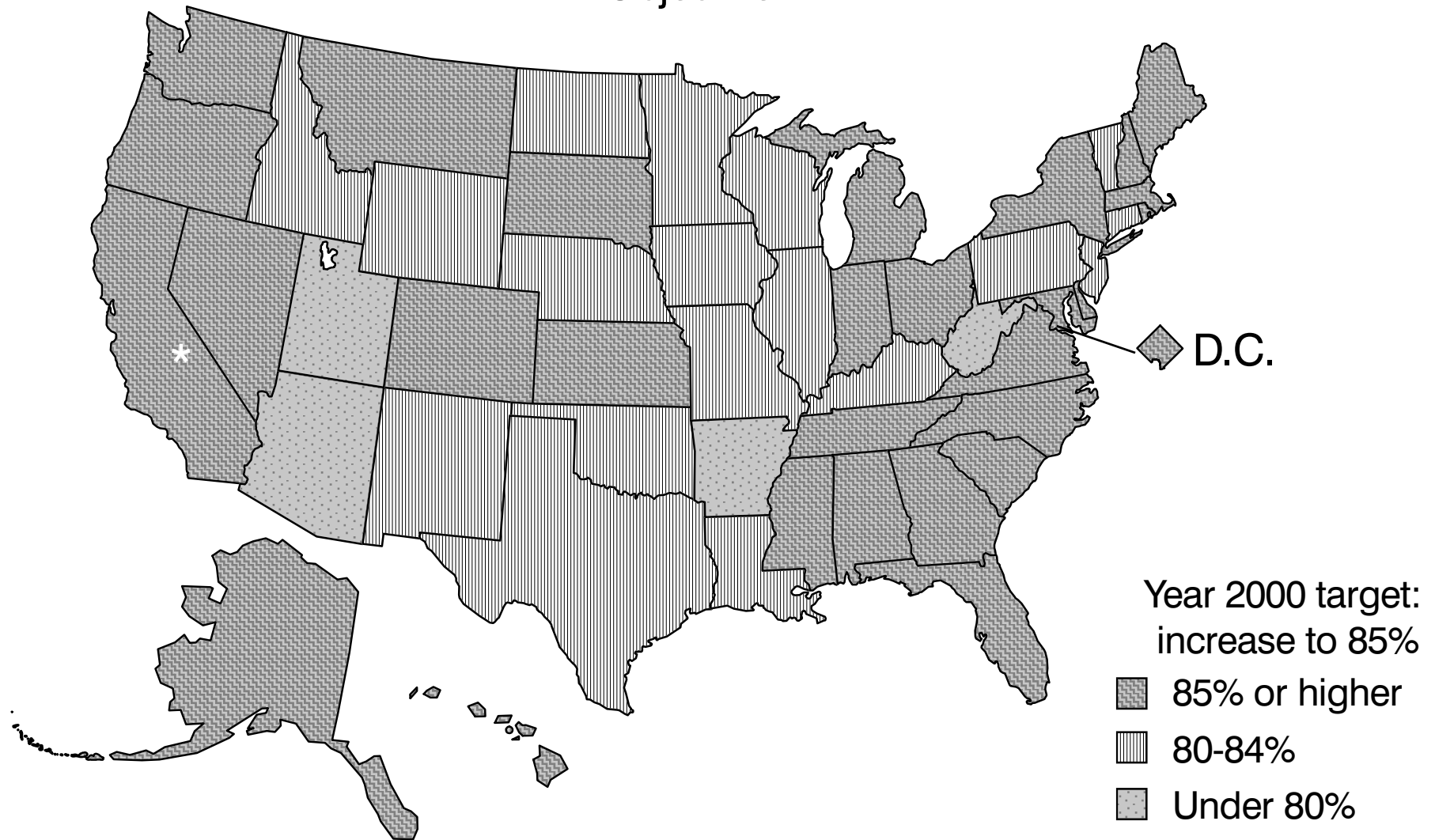

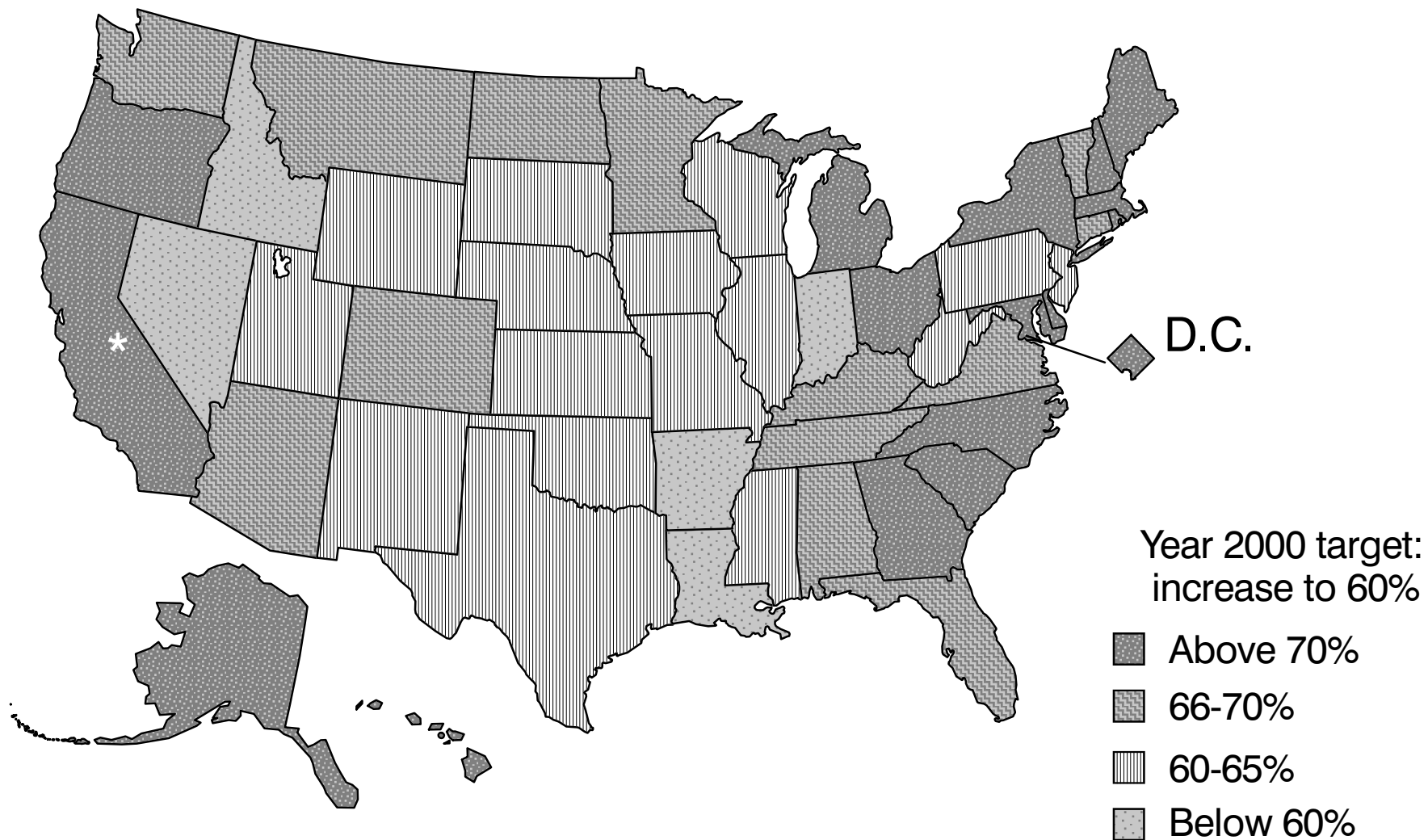
# Women 18 years and over who had a Pap test in past 3 years Objective 21.2

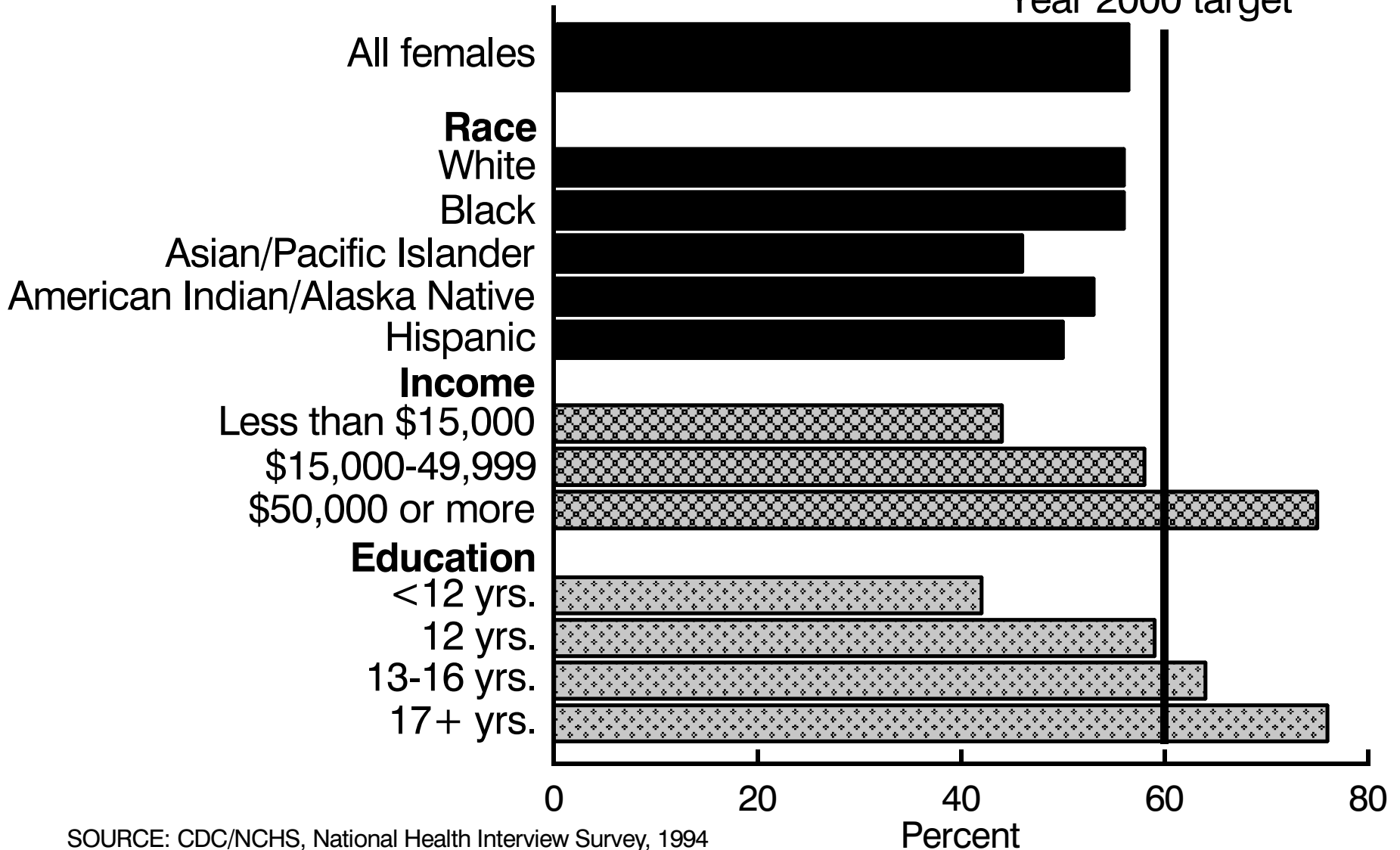

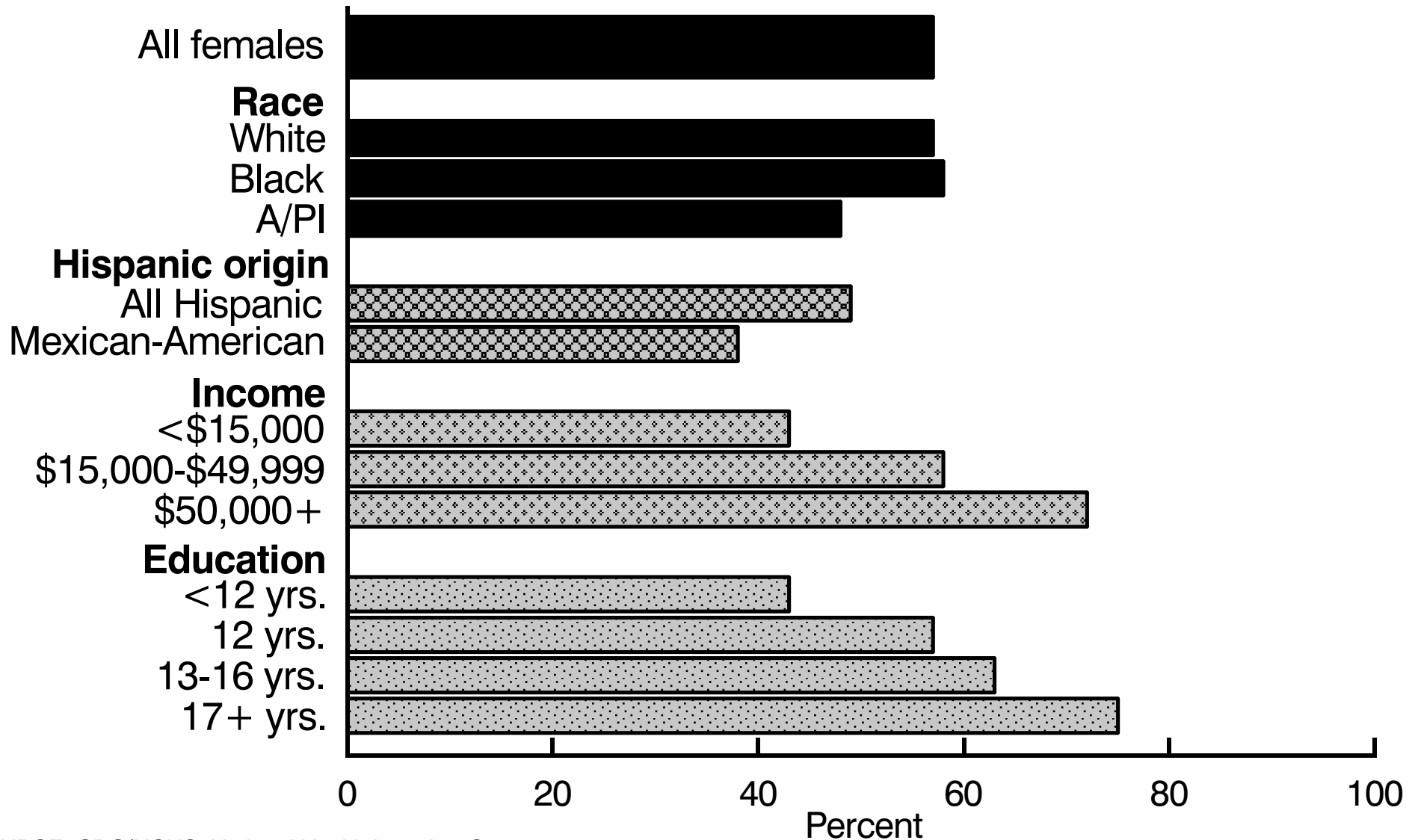

# Women 40 years and over who received a breast exam and mammogram in past two years

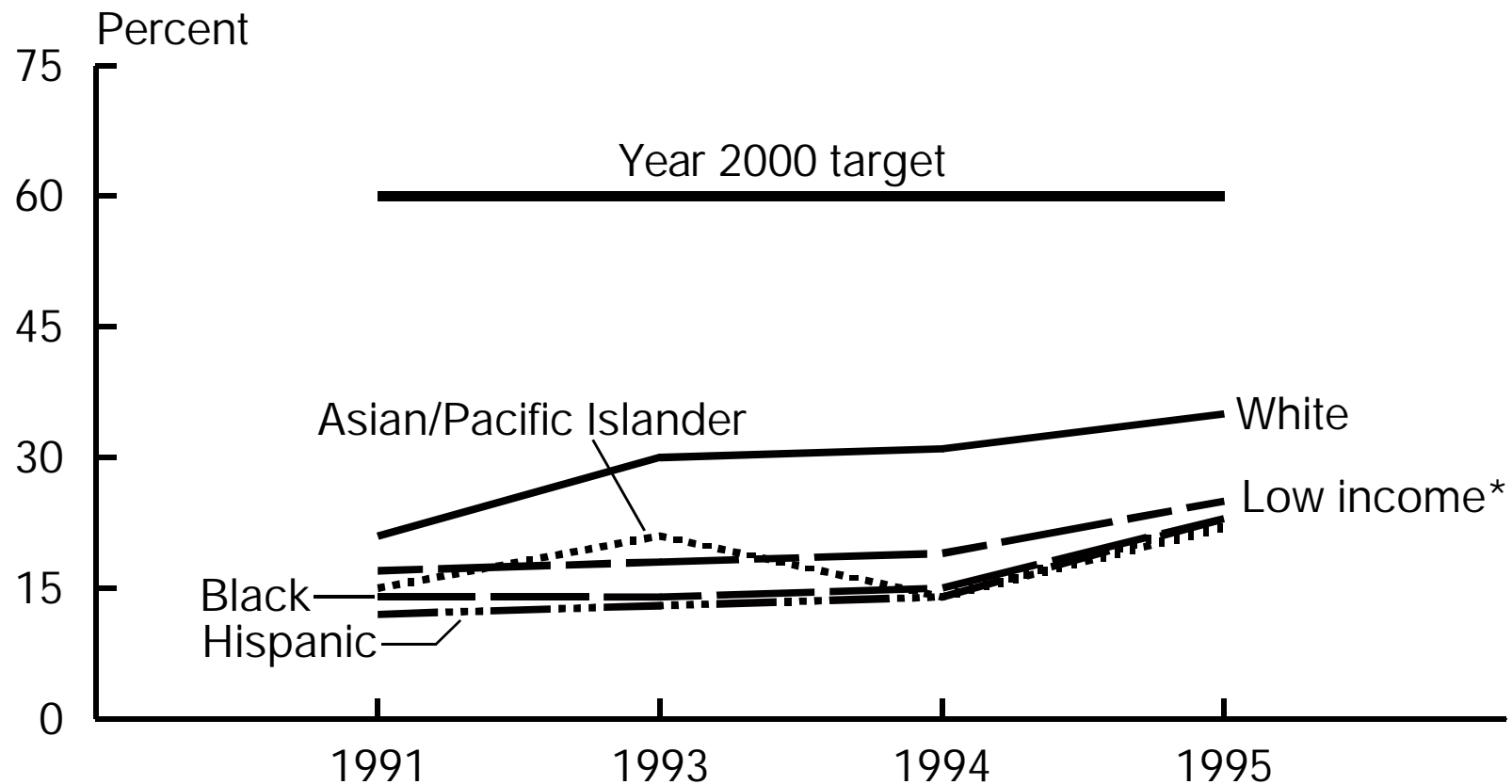

# Persons 65 years and over who had ever received a pneumococcal vaccination

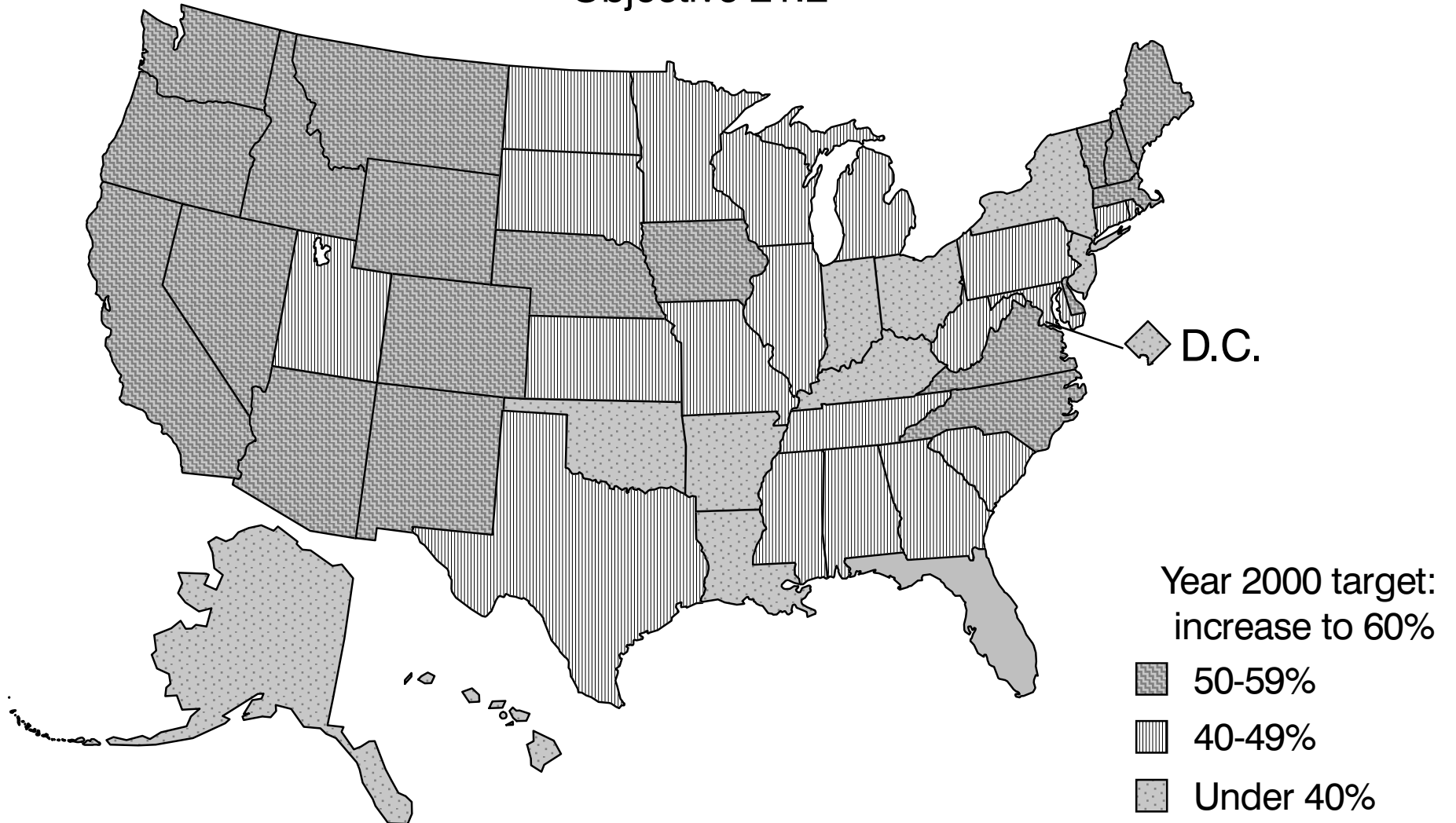

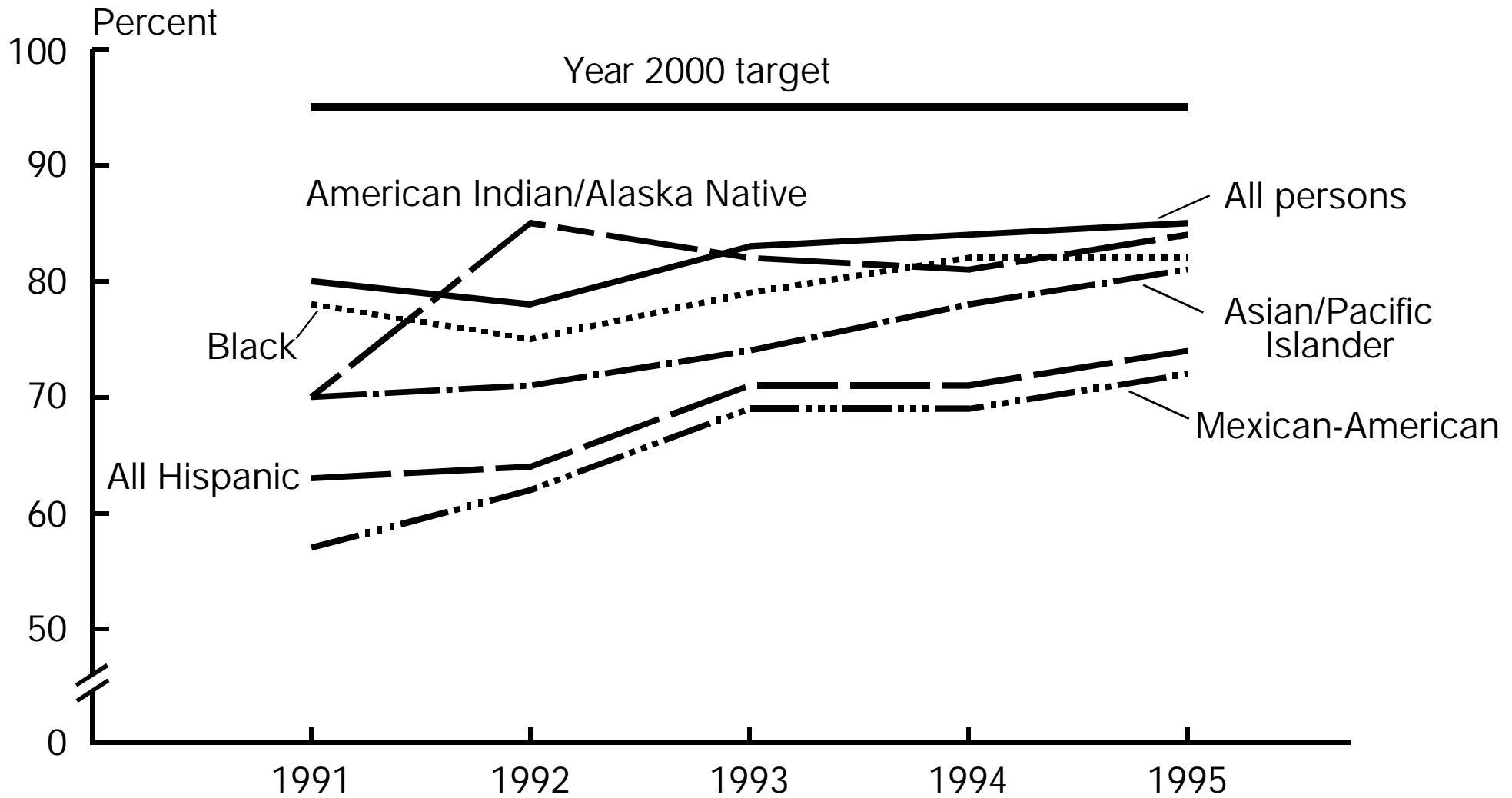

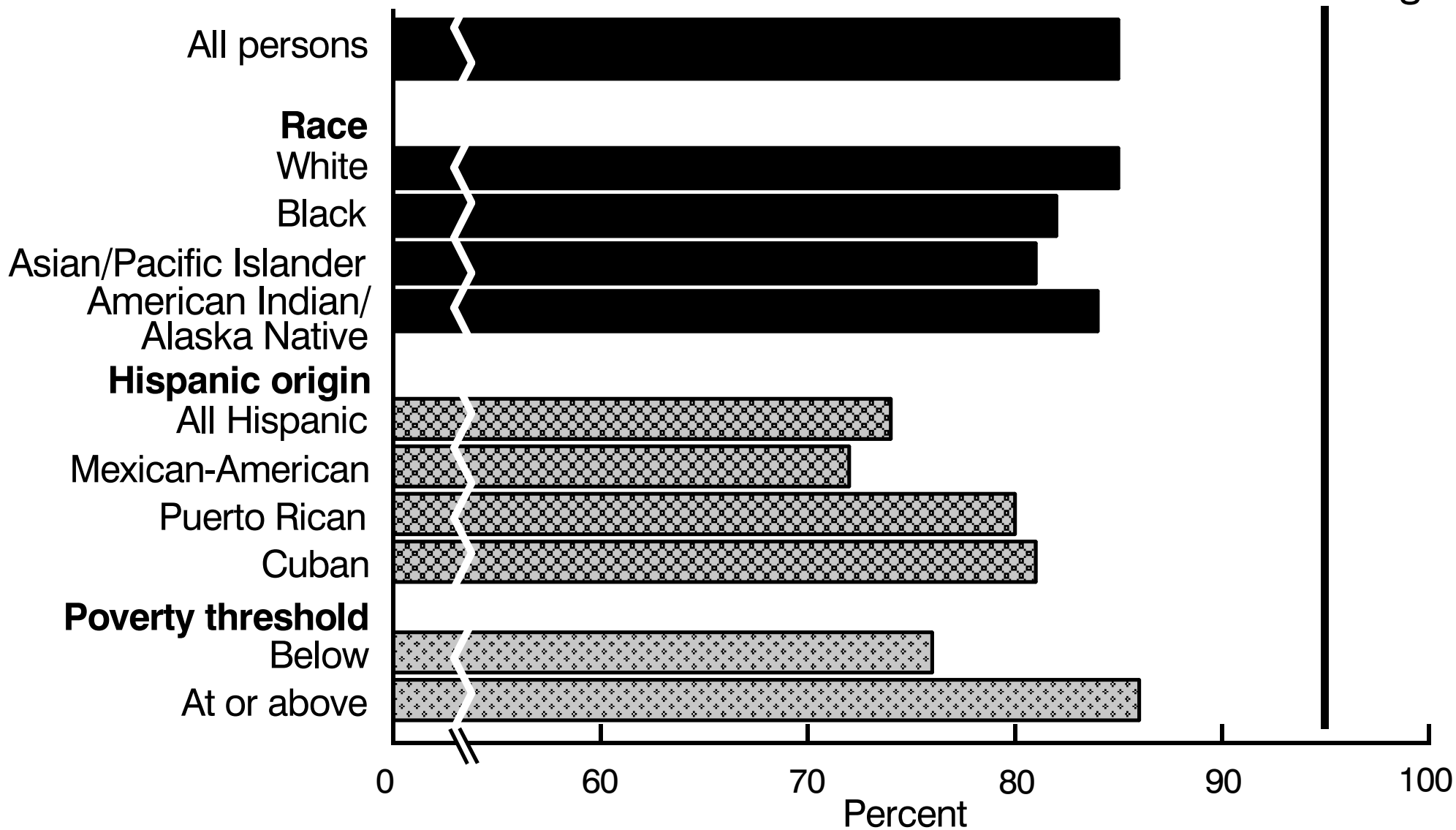

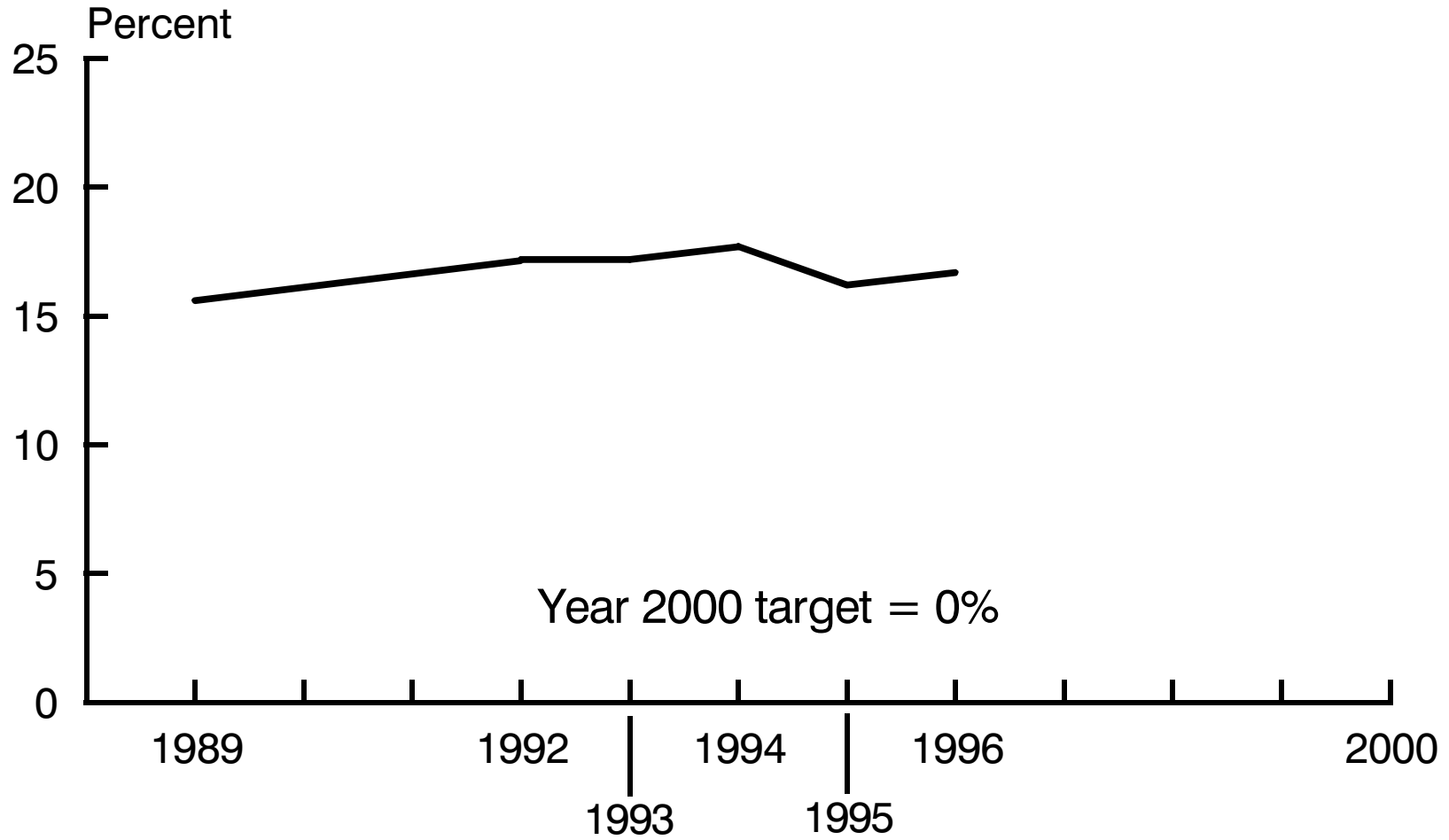

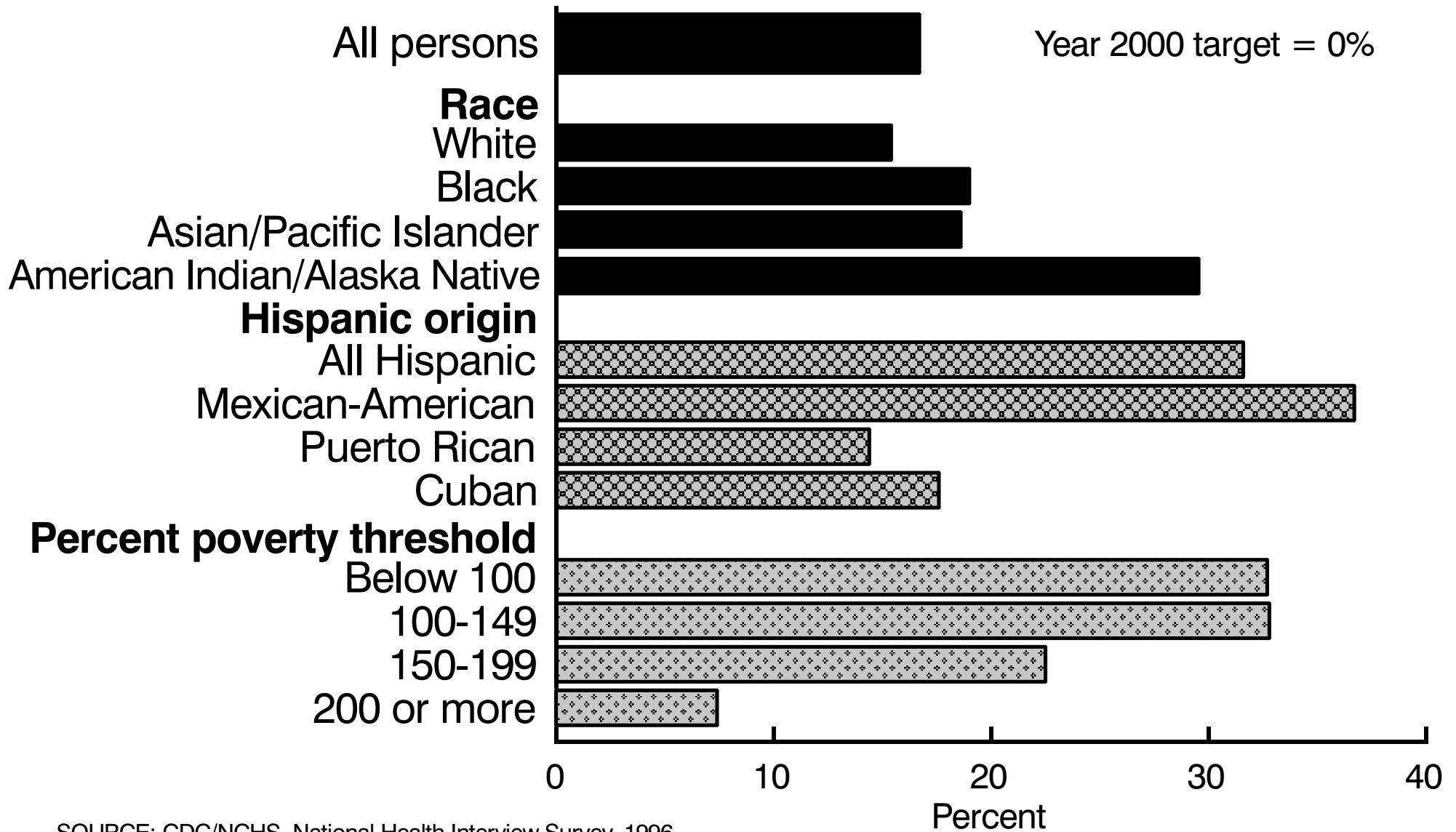

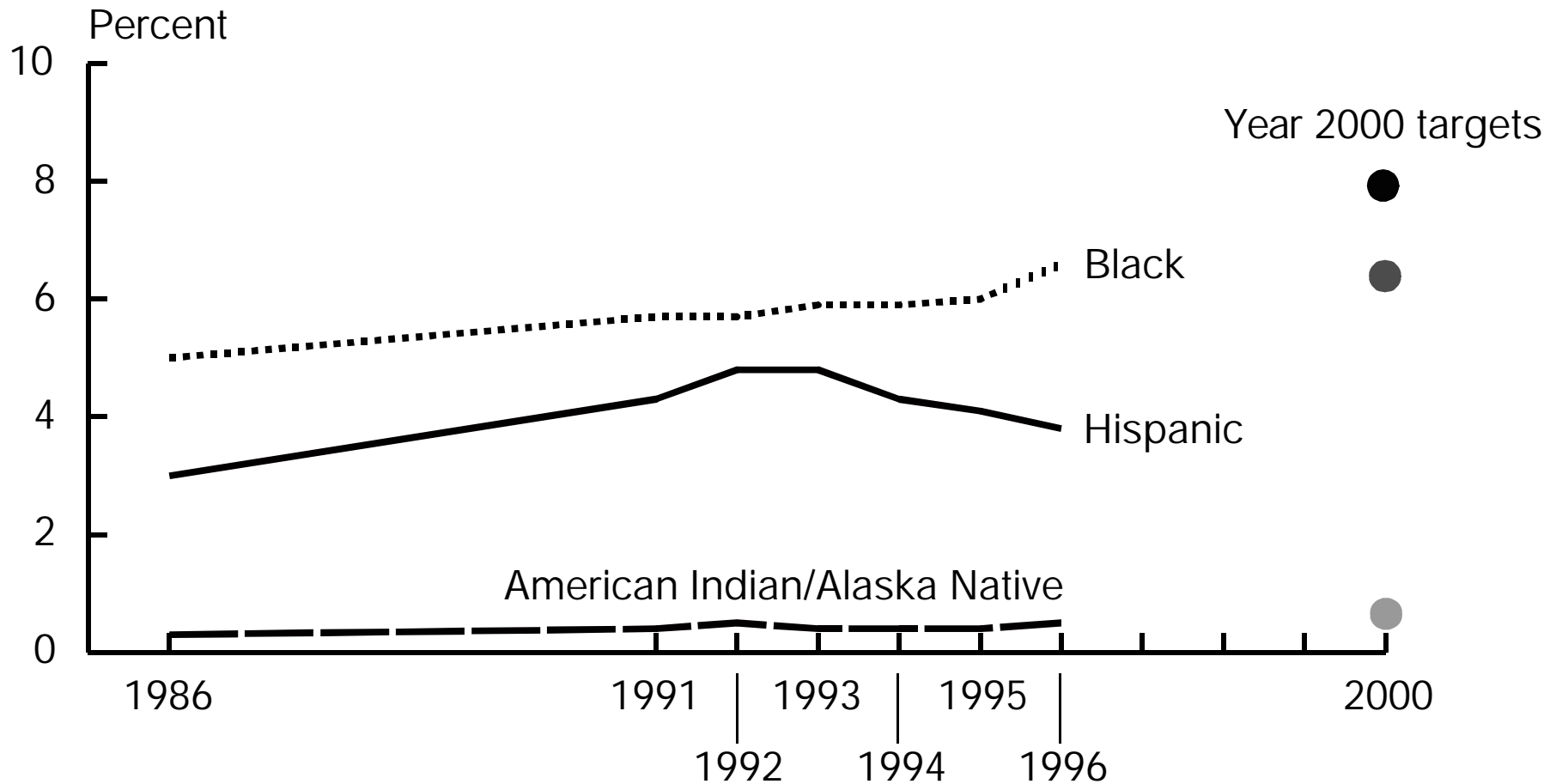

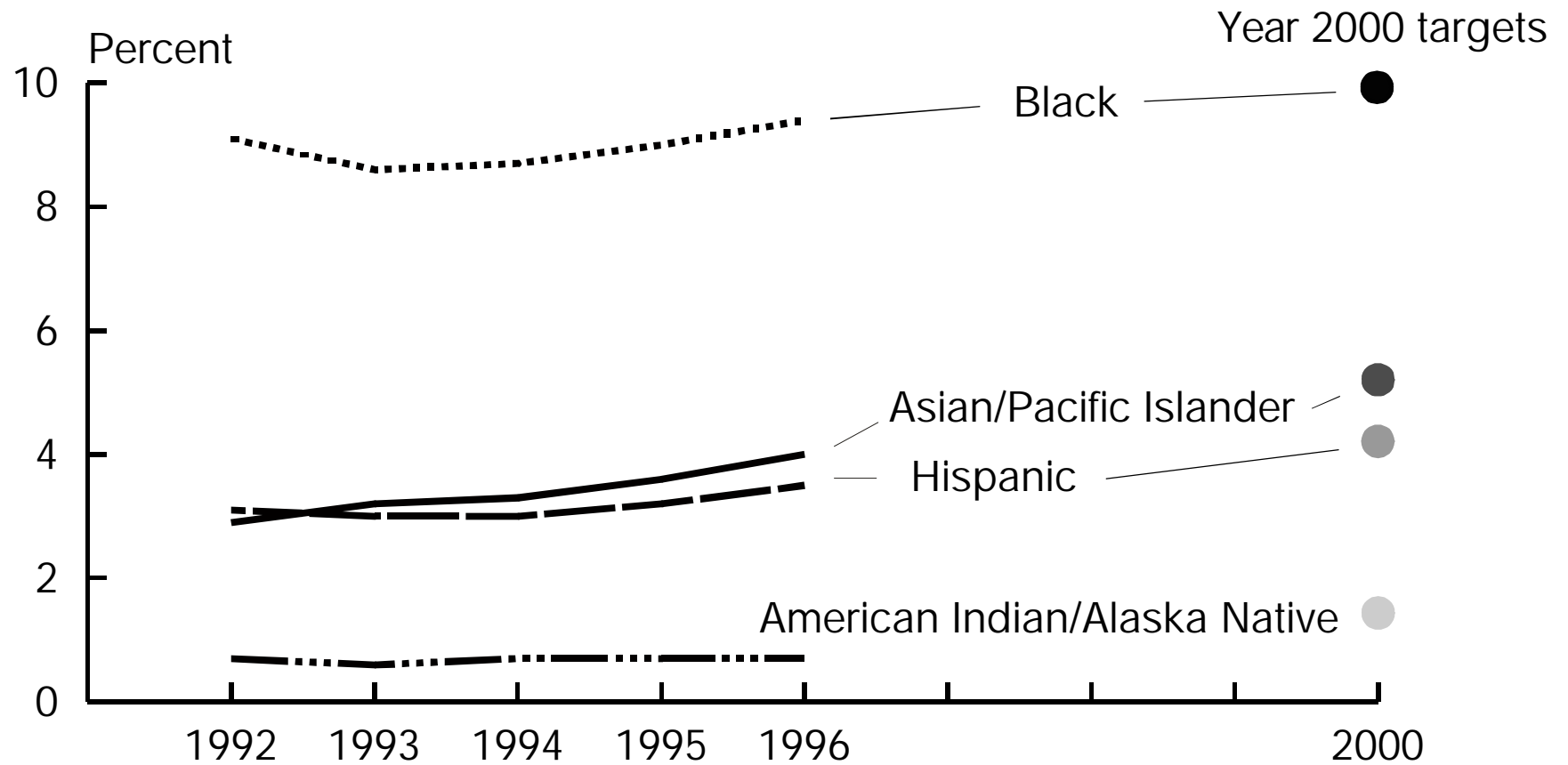
