Are YOU interested in making a difference in our children's health and the environment?

Today's School Buses: Our Children at Risk

Thousands of local children start and end each day with a ride on a big yellow school bus. Many school buses on the road today are aging diesel-powered vehicles. Older school buses expose children, whether they are waiting at a bus stop or riding a bus, to greater levels of air pollution. Children are particularly susceptible to the harmful impacts of diesel soot and exhaust fumes.

Clean, Safe Alternatives

In 130 school districts across 17 states, children ride "clean fuel" buses to school. These communities are enjoying cleaner air and lower costs. Unfortunately for most school districts, limited funds are available to assist with replacing or retrofitting vehicles to reduce toxic air emissions.

Solutions at Hand: The Adopt-A-School Bus Program

It was out of this need that the Adopt-A-School Bus Program was born! A cooperative partnership between the American Lung Association, EPA, State Agencies, local elected officials, and corporate sponsors was established as a nonprofit grant program to aid local school districts replacing their aging, diesel school bus fleets with new "clean fuel" buses.

The program is administered by an independent Steering Committee and operates under the auspices of the American Lung Association.

A "Win-Win" Partnering Opportunity

The Adopt-A-School Bus Program gives business and community leaders like you a unique opportunity to

- reduce the health risk to our children
- speed the replacement of the oldest, most polluting, diesel buses by combining corporate donations with matching school district funds
- improve air quality in your community

Funding awarded through the program will offset a portion of a school district's costs to convert to a GREEN bus fleet. Also, in order to ensure the longevity of the new buses, 10% of all grant money awarded will be earmarked for fleet infrastructure and maintenance.

The program will make its debut in the Dallas/Fort Worth area. Later, we will expand our efforts and "footprint" the program in other "at risk" communities.
